## Class Title: Half-Square Triangle Quilt

## Supply List:

You will need:
-Your sewing machine and $1 / 4$ inch foot. (Don' $t$ forget the pedal and power cord.)
-The pattern "Half Square Triangle Sampler" by Jeni Baker
-At least three fat quarters and one needs to be a light color (so we can make practice triangles
-Per the pattern, choose your fat quarters and a background so you can get a head start
-A spool of white and light gray thread; I recommend Quilter's Select 60 weight with matching prewound bobbins (at least one since not all bobbins hold the same amount of thread)
-A new Sharps needle 75/11
-Seam ripper (my favorite is the Clover brand with the white handle)
-12-1/2-inch square ruler and a 6-1/2-inch x 24 -inch ruler and cutting mat
-45 mm rotary cutter with a new blade
-Spray starch (such as Best Press)
Fabric scissors, thread snips; have you tried the new Kai scissors?
-Straight pins and pin cushion (my favs are the Clover brand blue flower head or the fine orange and green glass head)
-Three (3) large (gallon) zip top bags; pad of post it notes and a sharpie or ball point pen
