Meadowland Quilt Class Supply List

The Meadowland Quilt Pattern is a great beginner friendly, block-based pattern. It is very versatile because you can use FQs or 1/2 yards. Meadowland is the pattern you won't be able to stop making! It comes in six sizes and is easily customizable as it is block based.

You will need:

Your sewing machine! (Remember the pedal and power cord.)

Meadowland by Then Came June pattern; fabric requirements depend on what size you want to make

Quilt in a Day Flying Geese ruler, 2022QD and Frixion marker

At least two fat quarters, one needs to be a light color (for practice Flying Geese)

Thread—I recommend Quilters Select 60 weight with matching prewound bobbins (at least one since not all bobbins hold the same amount of thread)

A new Sharps needle 75/11

Seam ripper (my favorite is the Clover brand with the white handle)

6-1/2-inch x 24-inch ruler and cutting mat and 45mm rotary cutter with a new blade

Spray starch (such as Best Press)

Fabric scissors, thread snips; have you tried the new Kai scissors?

Straight pins and pin cushion (my favs are the Clover brand blue Flower head or the fine orange and green glass head)

Three (3) large (gallon) zip top bags; pad of post it notes and a sharpie or ball point pen

Nice to have:

16-1/2-inch square ruler for proofing your blocks

12-1/2-inch square ruler for cutting fat quarters OR Stripology ruler

Clapper—helps to press the block seams flat
