
1. SAFETY INFORMATION


Please read this user manual carefully before using this product. Important - Keep these instructions for future reference.

- WARNING Never leave your child unattended.
- WARNING Ensure that all the locking devices are engaged before use.
- WARNING To avoid injury ensure that your child is kept away when unfolding and folding this product.
- WARNING Do not let your child play with this product.
- WARNING Avoid serious injury from falling or sliding out. Always use the restraint system.
- WARNING Check that the pram body or seat unit or car seat attachment devices are correctly engaged before use.
- WARNING This product is not suitable for running or skating.
- WARNING This product is suitable for children from 0 to 36 months. The max load of this product is 23kg. Never overload. Overloading and excessive weight may lead to instability of the stroller.
- WARNING This product is suitable for children from 0 to 36 months when the backrest angle>150°; This product is suitable for children from 7 to 36 months when the backrest angle≤150°.

- WARNING The maximum permissible loading for shopping basket is 5kg.
 Overloading and excessive weight in the shopping basket may lead to instability of the stroller.
- WARNING Any additional accessories or parcels added to or hung from the stroller may cause instability.
- WARNING Use this product for only one child at a time.
- WARNING Accessories which are not approved by the manufacturer/ distributor shall not be used.
- WARNING Only replacement parts supplied or recommended by the manufacturer/ distributor shall be used.
- WARNING The brake system must be engaged when placing your child in this product or taking your child out of this product.
- WARNING Do not use if any part is broken, torn or missing.
- WARNING Avoid placing this product near naked heat sources such as electric bar fires, gas fires, etc., or where a child could gain access to any other kinds of hazards.
- WARNING Always use the crotch strap in combination with the waist belt.
- WARNING Always use the harness provided and make sure the harness is correctly fitted.
- WARNING Do not allow child to stand on the seat unit.
- WARNING Do not pull this product by bike, motorbike and car, or any vehicle.
- WARNING Child may slip into leg openings and strangle. Never use in a reclined carriage position unless waist and shoulder straps have been fasten.

3. ASSEMBLE THE STROLLER





Groove 4. Insert the front bumper into the connectors on each side of stroller until you hear a "click" sound. Please note that the groove should be on top. Pull on the front bumper to make sure it is attached securely.

To remove the front bumper, press the button on each side of the bumper bar and pull it out.

5. To open canopy, pull forward while holding the rear of canopy in place. To close, push to the rear of stroller.




WARNING! The footmuff is needed when the stroller is in a reclined position.

- (1) Remove the footmuff from underneath the stroller seat.
- ② Pull the footmuff over the base of the seat and fasten the buckles on both sides of the frame.

Note: The footmuff may be folding back under the stroller seat when not in use.


4. SECURE THE HARNESS

WARNING! Always use the 5-point safety harness and ensure your child is properly secured when using the stroller.



1. Fasten the buckles on the central bucket until you hear a "click"sound. Make sure the harness buckle is secure by pulling the shoulder belt upwards.


To release the harness, press the plug towards inside, then pull out the socket.



2. Adjust the waist belt buckle to left or right according to the size of child.

To adjust the straps length, move the belt buckle to left or right to fit the size of the child.



3. To remove the shoulder belt, remove the hook buckle from the shoulder belt.

To assemble the shoulder belt, hook the hook buckle onto the shoulder belt.


5. BACKREST ADJUSTMENT



The backrest can be adjusted to multiple positions.

To recline backrest:

1. Squeeze the button on the backrest adjustor and slide the adjustor downwards to desired position.




For upright position:

2. Place the backrest upright and push the backrest adjustor up the webbing. To raise backrest, do not squeeze the button on the backrest adjustor.

6. BRAKES ADJUSTMENT


WARNING! Always lock brakes. Check the brakes are engaged by trying to push the stroller.



Front wheels:

1. To lock front swivel wheels, push the lock upwards.

To unlock front swivel wheels, press the lock downwards.



Rear wheels:

2. To engage rear brakes, step on the brake lever located near the rear wheel. Make sure the brakes are fully engaged by trying to push the stroller.


To release rear brakes, lift up the brake lever.

7. FOLDING THE STROLLER


8. CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE



1. Before folding the stroller, always close the canopy by pushing it to the rear of stroller.



2. Press the folding button ① and push the handle bar ② downwards to fold the stroller according to the direction of the arrow as shown in ③.



3. Secure the stroller with the locking latch.

Periodically check the stroller for damaged or worn parts. Do not use this stroller if any part is damaged or worn.

Hard parts: It is recommended to clean moving parts regularly in order to maintain correct functioning. Clean the frame with a soft damp cloth with mild soap.

Stroller fabric: Fabric parts may be cleaned in accordance with the fabric care label. Don not machine wash. Stroller seat can be wiped clean with damp cloth if necessary.

Stroller seat and Basket: Wipe clean with damp cloth if necessary.

Do not leave the stroller exposed to heat e.g. open fire, heaters and other sources of strong heat.

If the stroller frame has been exposed to salt water, please rinse the frame with clean fresh water as soon as possible afterwards.

If the stroller is wet, leave it unfolded and allow all parts to dry completely to prevent mould. Never store the stroller in a damp or hot environment.
