

1. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read this user manual carefully before using this product. Important - Keep these instructions for future reference.

- Please read this manual carefully before use and keep it for future reference. Failure to follow this instruction may affect the safety of children.
- Please do not leave the child unattended
- Please buckle the seat belt when the child is in the stroller.
- When children are riding, the caregiver should not leave.
- When children ride, they must use seat belts.
- This product is suitable for children aged 0-36 months. Do not use it for children over 4 years old or weighing more than 22kg (48 lbs).
- Please make sure all locking mechanism is locked before using the stroller.
- Please make sure that all locking devices are locked before using the stroller. Placing any load on the handle will affect the stability of the vehicle.
- Do not use the front armrest as the handle of the stroller to lift the stroller or children, so as to prevent the front armrest from falling off and causing unnecessary injury.
- Do not leave the stroller on the slope.
- The maximum load-bearing capacity of the basket is 2kg(4.4 lbs).
- The braking device should be activated when the child is placed in the stroller or taken out of the stroller.
- Do not fold the stroller when the child is in the stroller.
- Do not disassemble the stroller or adjust any parts of the stroller while the child is in the stroller.
- Do not put plastic bags or bags beside the stroller to prevent children from suffocating.
- The use of accessories not provided by the manufacturer is prohibited.
- When the angle between the backrest and the seat cushion is adjusted to less than 150 degrees, it is not suitable for children under 6 months.


WARNING: Never leave child unattended.


WARNING: Avoid serious injury from falling or sliding out. Always use seat belt.

WARNING: Parcels or accessory items, or both, placed on the unit may cause the unit to become unstable.





6. The adjusting buckle can be found at the back of the backrest.

A. As shown in the figure, the backrest angle adjustment buckle clip (I). Hold the backrest adjusting buckle clip with one hand, pull the backrest adjusting ribbon up and down to adjust, then the angle of backrest can be raised or lowered.


B. Tighten the backrest adjustment clasp upward to adjust the seat. Similarly, the reverse operation will return to the flat state.

5. SEAT DISASSEMBLY



1. The seat does not need to be disassembled, it can be directly rotated and adjusted to the forward and reverse mode.




2. As shown in the figure, stretch the adjusting handle under the seat pedal outward ①, and then lift the pedal upward to an upright state ②, and it can rotate.



The reverse state after rotation.

Note: The rotation of the seat is only operated when the back rest is upright.




1. When disassembling the seat, first pinch the quick release handle ①under the seat, and then directly lift the seat to eparate the frame from the seat


2. When installing, just snap the seat directly onto the frame.

7. USE OF SAFETY BUCKLES




- 1. Front armrest disassembly: Press the front armrest quick release button ② on the outer sides of the front armrest to remove the front armrest as shown in status ①.
- 2. Front armrest installation: Just align the front armrest with the holes on both sides of the seat and insert it until you hear a "click" sound to indicate that the installation is complete.



1. To release the harness, press the release buckle and remove the left and right components of the magnetic buckle.

To fasten the buckle, assemble the right and left buckle components respectively. Finally, piece the left buckle onto the right, followed by the central buckle.




2. Seat belt adjustment:


Pull one end of the safety strap and slide the buckle up and down to adjust the length of the belt.



10. CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE



② **GO**

As shown in the figure, step on the brake pedal to engage the stroller in 'brake' mode. Lift the brake pedal to resume normal operations.

NOTE: Please engage the brake when stroller is not in motion.

- Please use non-toxic, non-abrasive cleaners to clean your stroller. Mix water and a small amount of mild non-toxic detergent into a solution. Wipe it to the frame with a damp cloth. Never use abrasive cleaners or solutions.
- If you need to leave the stroller idle for a period of time, do not store it in a humid or high temperature environment, otherwise it will easily lead to rust and aging of the parts. Allow air to circulate around the seat, and do not stack any objects on the seat. So as not to affect the service life of the product or cause danger.
- Please use a rain cover when it rains. Dry the stroller before it can be folded and stored.
- Regularly check whether there are loose screws, damaged parts or broken sutures. If the part is damaged, please stop using it.
- When disassembling and assembling, please follow the instructions carefully to avoid unnecessary damage.
