

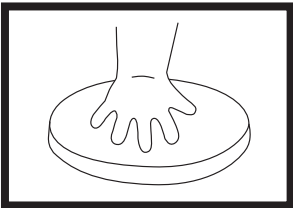
Sculpey Keepsake.

Air Dry Keepsake Impression Kit



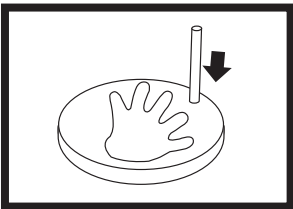
Start with clean hands and work surface. Good working surfaces include a Sculpey® Oven-Safe Work Mat, glass or metal surface, disposable foil or wax paper.

Step 1 – Knead clay for approximately 30 seconds. It should be a smooth consistency.



Step 2 – Place Sculpey® Oven-Safe Work Mat, wax paper or aluminum foil down on the table. Form a Ball and flatten with roller to size of ring (Approx. 5.25"). Make sure that the clay is thick enough for a good impression. Use the ring as a cutter and cut out the circle. There should be very little excess clay.

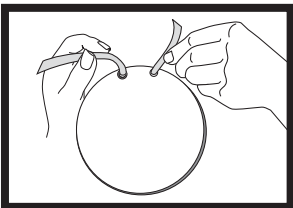
Step 3 – Wash and dry child's hand or pet's paw.



Step 4 – Leave space on the bottom or side for name/date and on top for 2 hang holes. Press child's hand or pet's paw firmly into clay. If you are unhappy with the impression, repeat steps 3 and 4.

Step 5 – Use hole punch to make 2 holes at the top of the ornament for hanging.

Step 6 – Add name or date with toothpick.



Step 7 – Allow the clay to fully dry for at least 24 hours. Check the ornament and if not dry, flip over and allow to dry further. Do not heat or bake.

Step 8 – Thread ribbon from the back of ornament through to the front on both sides. Tie a knot and then make a bow. Your ornament is ready to hang!

CREATIVE IDEAS:

- 1 – Add name to ornament using red or green permanent marker after drying.
- 2 – Add glitter glue to your dried ornament to add sparkle.
- 3 – Instead of a handprint, do a footprint ornament.
- 4 – Use your pet's tag in the ornament—push the metal tag into the impression medium before allowing to dry.
- 5 – Paint the ornament with acrylic paint for a festive look.
