# Garden Roses LLC - Photography Contest

Garden Roses LLC is looking for some new photos to add to our website!

### Rules

- 1. Must be of a rose on this list. Please enter only 1 photo per rose (so pick your best photo!)
- 2. Photo must be a minimum resolution of 800 px by 800 px with a recommended resolution of 2048 px by 2048 px.
- 3. File type must be one of the following: .JPG/.JPEG (Preferred), .HEIC, .PNG, .GIF, .AVIF, .WebP
- 4. Photo must either be cropped into a square (or be able to be cropped into a square without cropping out any major portion of the rose).
- 5. Photo must be your own (preferably from your own garden!) and not have any watermarks on it (we will be adding a uniform watermark to each photo and give credit to each entrant).
- 6. Please keep it to close up photos of the rose itself avoid photos of arrangements with multiple rose cultivars, photos from a distance, or photos that contain multiple roses in the same frame. (The rose featured needs to be the focal point of the photo).

### Entering

- 1. Please email photos to Nate@GardenRosesLLC.com. Please be mindful of file sizes when sending if you need to send multiple emails, that's okay.
- 2. Please use the following format for naming your photos in order to keep track of the rose, the photographer, and the zone as photos are downloaded:

**Personal Entry:** AUSsaucer\_NateFisher\_7a Business/Organization Entry: TheFairy\_GardenRosesLLC\_7a

FOR ROSES WHERE WE USE THE REGISTRATION NAME, PLEASE ENTER IT AS THE REGISTRATION NAME AND NOT THE TRADE NAME (i.e. if it starts with AUS, TAN, KOR, MEI, etc. on our list use that name).

<u>helpmefind.com/gardening/roses.php</u> is a good resource for cross-referencing names (you can enter either the registration name or the trade name and it will cross-reference for you).

- 3. Please specify how you want to be credited (i.e. "Nate Fisher" or "Garden Roses LLC", "Kimberley Dean" or "The Rose Geek").
- 4. Upon receipt and review of your photos, we will inform you of how many "entries" into the drawing you will have (each valid photo following our rules listed above will count as 1 entry). If your photo(s) fulfill our requirements, you receive an entry we are not restricting it to "our favorite photo" of each rose counting as an entry. Ideally, we'd like to have multiple photos of each rose from different entrants.

### Drawing

We will enter the names of all entrants into a random drawing generator. Each valid photo counts as 1 entry, so if you send photos of 5 roses on our list, you receive 5 entries.

Our drawing will be held on Facebook Live (<u>www.Facebook.com/GardenRosesLLC</u>) on **December 9, 2023, at 12:00 PM EST.** We will draw 10 names - each name drawn will receive a \$25.00 (digital) gift certificate to Garden Roses LLC. Winners will also be informed via email, and the list will also be posted to our social media pages.
