We pre cut and prepare cabinets to set sizes in bulk using the very best materials we can find, this helps to keep the cost as low as possible. We offer them Flat packed for the best Value, or Rigid.

What about Bespoke units?

If however your kitchen needs some cabinets we don't have here—don't worry—we can create bespoke cabinetry to go with this range — But please note due to cost restrictions, and to keep the cost as low as possible for you, we make bespoke cabinetry using the same materials as our fully bespoke "Classic" range, mainly this is Oak Veneered MDF for cabinetry, Beech frames, MR MDF doors.

They will look identical when fully finished and installed and is a great way to get a bespoke kitchen at an affordable price.

Please also note that we have limited stocks of pre cut and prepared cabinets—if when making yours we don't have stock of a certain of a cabinet we will build it for you at the same cost but from the "bespoke" materials listed above

CARE & GENERAL ADVICE

*Before delivery—Double check all measurements in the room, where you have tall cabinets measure up high also as walls can sometime be not 100% vertical

Then check the order form THOROUGHLY before you agree it, once we start production changes will incur costs.

Anything out of the ordinary you are expecting on a cabinet HAS to be on the order form, so if it was agreed make sure it is there, as this is what will be built.

Check access to the property, can you carry in some of the largest items fully assembled? If not let us know and we will flat pack those items

*Storage before fitting and after fitting—Your kitchen is made entirely out of wood. It is very important that it is stored in a Dry heated room when delivered and not left in a cold or damp room as it will soak up moisture from the environment.

It is also really important that you do not put your kitchen in a freshly plastered room that hasn't yet fully dried as again it will soak up moisture.

Moisture will cause the wood to expand, and cause rubbing, it will also cause hairline cracks to appear in the freshly painted paint which when the wood dries and shrinks back down may cause problems.

Fitting:-

- *Fitting— We have our own approved installers, they know the product inside out and will always leave you with a fantastically fitted kitchen. We often see "builders" fitting our kitchens, and whilst many do a great job, some really don't have the skills needed to fit an in-frame kitchen and can often cause more harm than good. Please speak to us about fitting if you are unsure of your fitters skills.
- *Sealing around the bottom— Once fitted we strongly recommend that you seal with a good quality silicone around the legs and plinth to the floor, this will stop water from mopping or spills being able to get under the legs and soak into the wood and cause these problems above.
- *Sitting water—Around sinks please do not allow water to sit on the frames or doors for long periods, we use water based paints and this will slowly cause damage as the water will eat away the paint and soak into the wood.
- *Dishwashers—We strongly recommend (as will all other kitchen manufacturers) that you do not open a dishwasher as soon as it has finished its cycle to let the steam out, please leave the dishwasher to cool off before opening. Steam is a very powerful substance and will penetrate the wood and paint and will cause damage to any kitchen door, but especially a painted one
