

FOR ALL VISITORS TO S&P's GLOBAL OFFICE at 55 Water Street (US)

For the health and safety of everyone entering S&P Global office at 55 Water Street, the Company requires all visitors to conduct the self-assessment below before entering.

Proof of COVID-19 Vaccination

Beginning December 27, 2021, all individuals who enter our New York office are required to be vaccinated and show their vaccination card or a State issued Vaccine Passport/Record etc. to S&P's lobby security team upon entry.

Please reschedule your visit if you are not vaccinated.

Face coverings

- **Masks are optional for those fully vaccinated**

Other Risk Factors

For the safety of our people, **do not enter the office if, now or in the previous 10 days, you have:**

1. **tested positive** for COVID-19
2. **traveled** for personal or business reasons, and local or national guidance requires that you remain quarantined (you are to review local and national requirements)
3. experienced any **symptoms** of COVID-19 or illness such as cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, fever (37.5°C / 99.5°F or higher), chills, muscle pain, sore throat or loss of taste or smell
4. knowingly been in **close contact** or shared accommodation with anyone* who has tested positive for COVID-19, traveled to or through any country or area identified in point #2 above, or exhibited any symptoms of COVID-19 or illness (*if you have been fully vaccinated at least 2 weeks, 'close contact' only applies to household members)
5. been **notified by applicable local authorities** to self-isolate, or a member of your household has been so notified

If any of the above apply to you, you are not to enter S&P Global offices, and we ask that you reschedule your visit for a later date when you can confirm all the above.

If you test positive for COVID-19 within 10 days after visiting the office, and health authorities are not conducting contact tracing in your area, we ask that you please inform your host so that S&P Global can take appropriate measures.
