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■ FINANCIAL CRIMES ENFORCEMENT Criminals did not sit idle during 2020; in fact, they accelerated their efforts in trying to take illicit advantage of the financial system as the world wrestled with how to carry out reputable business and banking operations. The ABA/ABA's 2020 **Financial Crimes Enforcement Conference** took up discussion of critical areas of concern for banking, legal, regulatory, and law enforcement specialists. Particular emphasis was placed on new fraud and cybercrime threats, US Bank Secrecy Act/ Anti-Money Laundering reform efforts, and the ongoing impact on COVID-19. Although the program was directed toward a US audience, the discussion insights presented are highly relevant to specialists in other jurisdictions challenged by fraud, AML, risk assessment, and the optimal means of applying new technology for fighting financial crime.
