The Rifleman Chardonnay is sourced from a vineyard co managed by Brad Case in the Adelaide Hills near Echunga. The cool climate of the Adelaide Hills is perfect for the development of classic Chardonnay characteristics over the long, slow ripening period

BLOCK NAME: CHA1 House

LOCATION: Rathmine Vineyard / Echunga

SOIL: Limestone within an alluvial loam

PLANTED: 1993

This wine shows lovely white floral, lemon curd characteristics with some nutty oak complexity, fabulous length and acid balance.

SUGGESTED FOOD PAIRINGS

Warm sautéed scallops
wrapped in prosciutto with lemon
Buerre Blanc



Vinification

Alcohol: 13.0

Titrateable acidity: 7.1

pH: 3.21

Hand picked & whole bunch pressed

Barrel fermented in French oak, approximately 20% new oak, medium toast for 8 months
