BLOCK NAME: West Block

AREA: 1.1 Hectares

SOIL: Sandy loam

PLANTED: 2014

Montepulciano was first planted on the Kimbolton Estate in 2006. The variety (originally from Southern Italy) was still a relatively new variety in Australia and has adapted well to the Langhorne Creek climate. Today Kimbolton produces Monte 3 ways, as a Rose, dry red and a sparkling red.

An elegant Rose showing hints of strawberries and cream with fresh acidity and a crisp dry finish.
