WINEMAKERS COMMENTS

Shiraz and McLaren Vale are synonymous, the region's climate and soils naturally enabling rich, flavoursome expressions of this classic variety. Fruit, is sourced from the two DOWIE DOOLE terroirs, with each vineyard contributing unique characters to the finished wine. The cool slopes and sandy soils of Blewitt Springs offer lighter blue fruits and a fine tannin line. The richer soils and Mediterranean climate of Tatachilla gift the wine with darker fruit and richness.

We carefully decide on the portions from the Dowie Vineyard of Blewitt Springs and the Doole vineyard of Tatachilla. The Dowie Vineyard offers fruit in the cooler climate Shiraz spectrum, while the Doole vineyard being more Mediterranean, offers fruit weight and more generous fruit. For the 2021 vintage, a blend of 60% Blewitt Springs and 40% Tatachilla was decided upon the best representation of the two terroirs of DOWIE DOOLE.
