



HOW TO DETERMINE YOUR RING SIZE

Figuring out the right ring size can be a bit challenging, so we've put together this guide for your convenience. However, for the most accurate measurement, we suggest visiting a local jeweler to be sized in person. While many of our rings can be adjusted to fit, please note that some designs, for example those with stones all around, may not be resizable. Important steps to assure the most accurate measurement

Ensure your printer's Page Scaling option is set to "NONE" before printing the sizing guide.

Once printed, confirm the guide's accuracy by measuring one of the two lines below.

If they match, you're ready to use the guide!

Measure an Existing Ring



- 1. Print this guide with page scaling set to 100%.
- 2. Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger.
- 3. Place the ring over the circles below. Match the inside edge of the ring to the circle closest in size.
- 4. If the ring falls between two sizes, order the larger size.
