Tools & Materials Required

- 1/4" Wood Lag screws – 3 per bracket
- Drill
- Phillips screw driver or driver bit
- Clear Silicone
- Level

The Townley Shelf Bracket creates beautiful open shelving. The bracket is made from 3/16" structural steel and features a unique ribbed design providing superior support in a low profile.

We recommend installing a bracket every 16" along the length of the shelf. The Townley Bracket should be mounted to wall studs or backing material greater than 1.5" thick. The Townley shelf bracket can be installed internally or externally to the wall.

Installation Instructions

1. Determine the ideal mounting height of your shelf. The bracket will mount at the bottom of the shelf.

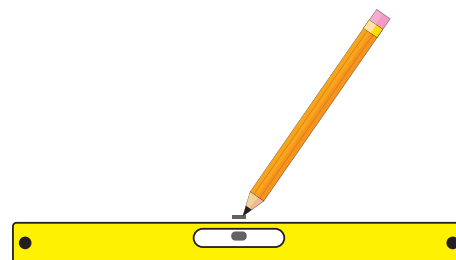

2. Using a level, mark the location for each bracket. The Townley Bracket should be installed to studs or backing material greater than 1.5" (see Figure 1).

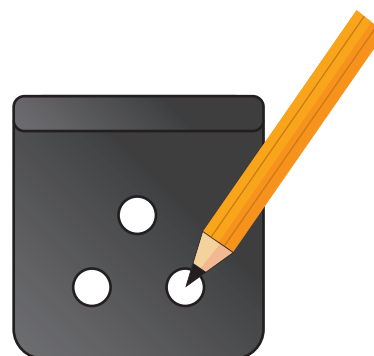

3. Use the bracket to mark the location of pilot holes. Drill Pilot holes with a drill bit slightly smaller than 1/4" (see Figure 2).

Installation Instructions

- Loosely secure each bracket with (3) 1/4" lag screws. Place a level across the brackets to ensure each bracket is level before tightening the screws all the way (see Figure 3).

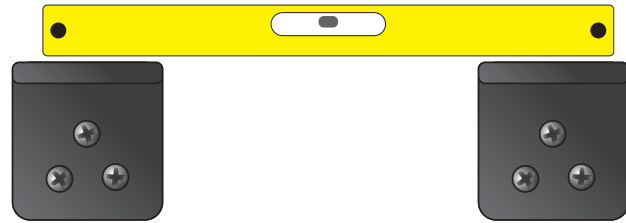

- Use clear silicone to attached the shelf to the bracket. The Townley bracket has an hole to use an optional wood screw to secure the shelf to the bracket (see Figure 4).

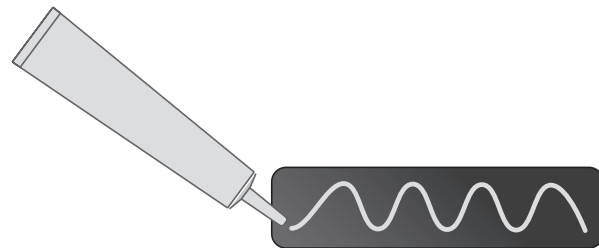

The following products are not covered under this warranty: (1) brackets that have been altered, modified, neglected or poorly maintained; (2) brackets that are purchased in used condition, not in original packaging, or from an unauthorized dealer or distributor; (3) brackets that have been damaged during transit or shipping.

The following damages are not covered under this warranty: (1) damage to persons or property due to improperly installed or repaired brackets as recommended by SDS; (2) damage from causes other than defects in materials and workmanship such as a purchaser's or installer's lack of skill, competence or experience.

SDS's obligation under this warranty is limited to one the following at the sole option of SDS: (1) replacement of the defective bracket; (2) supply of equivalent goods; (3) the payment of the cost of replacing the bracket; or (4) The payment of the cost of having the bracket repaired.

SDS's sole obligation and your exclusive remedy under this warranty shall be limited to the cost of such repair or replacement. SDS's aggregate liability, if any, in damages or other-wise, shall
