

#### **OFF-LICENCE**

Sections 17 to 20 and Section 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 Greytown Distilling Company Ltd is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol on or from the premises situated at 110 Main Street, Greytown, and known as Greytown Distilling Company, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply complimentary samples of alcohol on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

## CONDITIONS OF LICENCE

The following conditions are consistent with the style of off-licence sought:

a. Alcohol may be sold on, or delivered from the premises for consumption off the premises, or supplied free as a sample for consumption on the premises, only on the following days and hours

Monday to Sunday 10:00 am to 4:00 pm

- b. No alcohol is to be sold on, or delivered from, the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday or Christmas Day or before 1:00 pm on ANZAC Day.
- c. No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Easter Sunday unless the alcohol is grape wine, or fruit, or vegetable wine made:

i. on the premises; or

ii. from grapes or fruit harvested from land on which the premises are situated.

- d. Drinking water is to be freely available to customers while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample, from the location at which the sampling occurs.
- A properly appointed certified manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises.
- The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display:
  - i. At each principal entrance to the premises, the ordinary operating hours during which the sale of alcohol is permitted.
  - ii. A copy of the licence and all conditions subject to which it is issued, to the inside of the premises so to be easily read by all people entering at each principal entrance.
  - iii. At every point of sale for alcohol, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons.

# THE LICENSED PREMISES

The premises, situated at 110 Main Street, Greytown are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date received by the South Wairarapa District Licensing Committee on the 8/08/22.

### DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from 110 Main Street, Greytown is designated as the principal entrance.

## **DURATION**

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

Until the close of the period of 3 years commencing with the date of its issue; or (a)

AND DISTRICT If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined; or (b)

If the licence is renewed, until the close of the period for which it is renewed. (c)

#### **DECISION**

This is an application by the **Greytown Distilling Company Ltd** for an off-licence in respect of premises situated **110 Main Street**, **Greytown** known as **Greytown Distilling Company**.

The application is in respect of premises in which the business is that of a retail store selling bicycles, giftware and merchandise relating to the Wairarapa region, including a range of gin distilled in Greytown and sold in novelty tins depicting Wairarapa history.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly, I deal with the matter on the papers.

## **REASON FOR DECISION**

I have considered this application on the basis of the reports received from the Alcohol Licensing Inspector, the Police and the Medical Officer of Health, who do not oppose the issue of the licence. In addition, the District Licensing Committee has received no objections from the community.

I, as the District Licensing Committee Chair:

- a. Am satisfied as to the matters to which the Committee must have regard as set out in section 105 of the Act; and
- b. Acting pursuant to section 99 of the Act, grant the **Greytown Distilling Company** an off-licence pursuant to sections 17 and 18 of the Act, subject to the following conditions of licence (a)-(g).

#### CONDITIONS OF LICENCE

It is recommended that the licence be issued subject to following conditions:

- Alcohol may be sold on from the premises for consumption off the premises or supplied free as a sample for consumption on the premises, only on the following days and hours: Monday to Sunday 10:00 am to 4:00 pm.
- b) No alcohol is to be sold on, or delivered from, the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday or Christmas Day or before 1:00 pm on ANZAC Day.
- c) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Easter Sunday unless the alcohol is grape wine, or fruit, or vegetable wine made:
  - i. On the premises; or
  - From grapes or fruit harvested from land on which the premises are situated.
- d) The premises are undesignated.

- e) A properly appointed certified manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises.
- f) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample, from the location at which the sampling occurs.
- g) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display:
  - i. At each principal entrance to the premises, the ordinary operating hours during which the sale of alcohol is permitted.
  - ii. A copy of the licence and all conditions subject to which it is issued, to the inside of the premises so to be easily read by all people entering at each principal entrance.
  - iii. At every point of sale for alcohol, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons.
