



THE AUGUST QUILTED HAMMOCK—SINGLE

Assembly Instructions and Care Manual

WEIGHT CAPACITY

WHAT'S INCLUDED

1 hammock with the hammock bag

CAUTION:

Prior to each use of your hammock, inspect the product for signs of weakness or wear, including, but not limited to: the mounting hardware, installation points and objects supporting your hammock. Do not use if there are any signs that the material or supports are not in proper condition.



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

If you plan to use a stand, we recommend a 13-foot stand.

Hang the metal O-rings on each end of the hammock on the hammock stand. Hardware on hammock stands may vary (some have S-hooks, some have curved points/pegs in the metal, etc.) so please refer to manufacturer instructions of the hammock stand as well. Depending on the size of your hammock stand, there may be more or less slack in the hammock once hung.

To hang between trees, you'll need a minimum of 13 feet of distance between trees. Hammock tree straps for hanging between trees are available through outdoor retailers or online. Refer to hammock strap instructions for installation. For spaces that are several feet longer than your hammock, you can hang extra straps or lengths of chain to suspend your hammock.

For all installations:

- The hammock should be around 3 to 4 feet above the ground before any weight is placed in it.
- The ideal sit height between the ground and your hammock is 18 inches
- Fully tighten all hardware.
- Test the strength of the installation setup before using the hammock

WARNING

- Use only as directed.
- Install with help from professional if needed.
- Do not swing roughly or very high.
- Do not use this item as a swing, ladder, or any other unspecified use, as it may cause serious injury.
- Adult supervision required for children's use.
- Check and tighten all parts regularly.
- Do not stand on the hammock cradle.
- Do not jump onto the hammock.
- Ensure that the hammock is secured firmly.
- Position yourself in the center of the hammock and lower yourself slowly.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity on any products.
- Single hammock is meant to hold one person at a time.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Store your hammock in a cool, dry place. Remove any debris, like twigs, and be sure it is not wet or damp when rolled and stored.
- If hammock does get wet, let it air dry thoroughly before storing.
- Ensure that your hammock swings freely and does not drag on the ground.
- You can clean the hammock using a cloth or soft brush with a mild solution of water and detergent, and wipe with cold water and a cloth.
- Do not use any product with bleach or strong chemicals.
- Store away from chemicals and away from any birds or rodents.
