

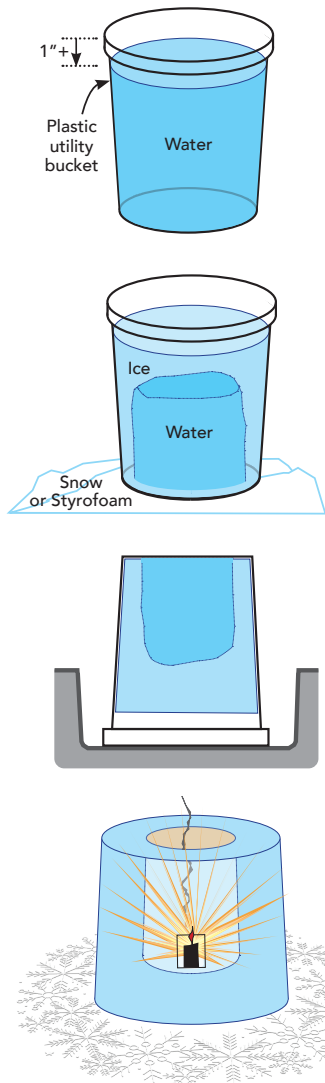

HOW TO MAKE AN ICE LANTERN?

An ice lantern is a shell of ice that shields a candle from wind, snow and rain or it can be lit with LED lights. Below are instructions for a simple bucket ice lantern (the tip of the iceberg in the ice-lantern-making craft). This is a great place to start!



STEP 1 Fill a utility bucket with water, leaving an inch or so at the top—depending on size of bucket.

STEP 2 Place it on snow, frozen ground or Styrofoam, to keep bottom from freezing. Freeze until ice is 1 to 2 inches thick (24 hours at 0° for a 5 gallon bucket).

STEP 3 Flip bucket in a sink or bathtub. Let thaw for 15 to 30 minutes, then slide bucket off and pour out water.

STEP 4 Place over a clustered string of outdoor LED lights or flip over and light with a floating candle. Display it in a spot where it can be discovered by your delighted neighbors and friends!
