## BACKGROUND

It all started during Covid when we took a year off to remodel our house. Once completed we had lots of large open wall space to decorate. You can see the results throughout our site with framed fabric prints used in our actual house.

We have developed four different options for you to showcase beautiful fabric prints. Whether you are checking out with one of our curated prints or creating something unique it is important that you select one of these options when prompted.

## O P T I O N 1

The first option is the simplest. Print and laser cut to requested size. Framing is your responsibility.


We can add two grommets to the upper left and right corners as well as adding a pole pocket in the bottom for adding a $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wooden dowel to provide enough weight so that the print hangs well on the wall. Dowels can be found at Lowes and Home Depot in different lengths.

## O P T I O N 3

Stretcher Bars offer a simple option for frames and are easy to purchase and put together. There are numerous options available on the internet. Blick offers stretcher bars up to $5^{\prime} \times 5^{\prime}$ at an affordable price, while Jerry's Artarama offers stretcher bars up to 96 ".

Be sure to select the stretcher bar option so we know to add 1 " additional on all sides of the print to wrap around the frame and secure with a staple
 gun. It is important that you maintain tension by pulling the fabric as you are stapling the print on the stretcher bar so there is no wrinkling. The fabric should be tight.

## O P T I O N 4

The For You DIY framing kit may be purchased on our site for $\$ 20$, and includes four metal corner joints developed to work with $2 \times 2$ furring strips which may be purchased at Lowes or Home Depot. Four furring strips are required to complete the frame. These strips come in $8^{\prime}$ lengths, which is why our maximum print size is to $8^{\prime} \times 8^{\prime}$. Larger size prints are available upon request.


Instructions are included with each DIY framing kit to assist with building the frame. Helpful tips are also included like securing your indoor prints to a wall by applying double sided tape to the back of frame in key areas. Also, for outdoor use, simply attach the print to your surface with small corner braces also available at Lowe's or Home Depot.

PLEASE NOTE: Treated wood should be purchased for outdoor prints. Also, carefully inspect furring strips when purchasing to ensure they are not warped.
