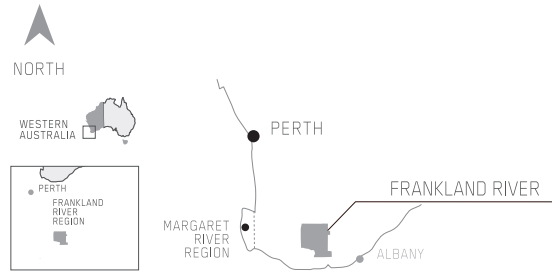


Varieties

Tempranillo

Region

Frankland River



Vineyards

We source a single vineyard in the Frankland River Region for this wine. This region is perfectly suited to producing many red and white varieties due to its continental climate combined with low vigour and moderate ripening conditions. A cool climate region which results in wines with elegance and structure.

Season

The 2018 vintage will go down as another outstanding one in Margaret River. Leading into vintage we had favourable conditions for flowering and fruit set, followed by ample rainfall to ensure vine canopies and fruit balance where at their best. Vintage conditions were perfect for ripening and resulted in a return to a harvest that commenced in mid-February and concluded in mid-April. Mild weather and little disease pressure has resulted in wines that have beautiful flavours and great natural acidity.

Harvest Date

March 2018

Winemaking

Machine harvesting during the cool of the night in order to maintain optimal fruit integrity. The grapes are destemmed, crushed and pressed under cool gentle conditions. The unfermented grape juice is soaked on its skins for 5 hours prior to the juice being pressed off to a holding tank. Cold fermentation ensures that the fruit flavours and aromas are conserved in the finished wine.

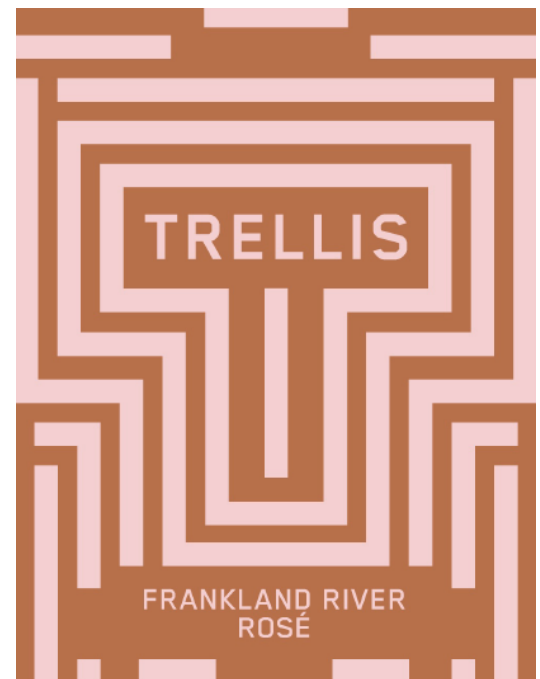
