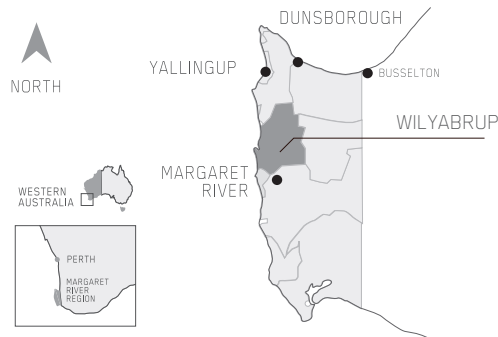


Varieties

Region

Margaret River



Vineyards

The Wilyabrup sub-region of Margaret River is predominantly sourced for its consistency in producing rich fruit flavours and a small percentage is sourced from the Treeton sub-region of Margaret River, located further south, providing subtle and elegant aromatics and fine tannins.

Season

The 2019 vintage was long and cool, picking occurred 2 weeks later than we traditionally do, the cool conditions allowed the grapes to slowly ripen resulting in perfectly balanced flavours and natural acidity.

Harvest Date

March/April 2019

Winemaking

A number of parcels are sourced for this blend, once the grapes have reached optimal ripeness the fruit is harvested during the cool of night for delivery to the winery. The fruit is destemmed and sent to static fermenters for a long cool fermentation. Once pressed off skins the wine is pressed off to oak barrels for 9 months maturation of 9. Finally the wine is removed, carefully blended and prepared for bottling.
