

Puppy Booster Schedule: First Year

DHPP	1st Dose: @ 6-8 weeks old (ideally)	Given every 3 weeks until 16 weeks of age	Given every 3 weeks until 16 weeks of age	1st "Adult" Vaccine: Given 1 year after puppy vaccines were finished (usually @ 16-17 months old)

NOTES

DHPP: What's important is NOT the total number of boosters a puppy receives but the age of the last one (16 weeks). For example a puppy who receives their first DHPP vaccine at 6 weeks may receive a total of 5 boosters vs a puppy who receives their first DHPP vaccine at 11 weeks may receive a total of 3 boosters

Leptospirosis, Lyme and Canine Influenza: Timing may vary based on circumstances and personal preferences
