

The backlight will blink red for 3 seconds and the keyboard will return into its default state.


How to Adjust the Actuation Sensitivity in DrunkDeer Antler

How To Change The Backlight Effect



The backlight effect can be changed by key combination as follow:

- Menu +R Turn on/off LED
- Menu +T Turn on/off the turbo mode To turn on/off the turbo mode
- Menu +Y Switch colors
- Menu +U Switch light effects
- Menu +F Lower brightness 10
- Menu +G Increase brightness
- Menu +H Lower light speed
- Menu + Increase light speed
