Leftover Paint from the Holiday Forest Animals Banner Kit
 Store bought acrylic
 Paint Brushes
 Cup of water
 Rag or towel
 Printer
 8.5x11 Card stock
 Scissors
 Pen

Paint:

- Forest Animals No. 1 (green)
- Forest Animals No. 2 (green + white)
- Forest Animals No. 4 (brown)
- Forest Animals No. 5 (brown + red)
- Forest Animals No. 6 (brown + red + white)
- Forest Animals No. 9 (red)
- Forest Animals No. 10 (red + white)
- Forest Animals No. 11 (metallic gold)

Instructions:

Note: For this project we used leftover paint from the Holiday Forest Animals Banner Kit, but feel free to use whatever you have. You may also purchase store bought acrylics to mix similar colors from just green, red, brown, white, and metallic gold (recommendations in parenthesis to the left). Just make sure to assign a number for each color to make it easy to follow the numbered template.

1. Print the place card template (pg 2) on card stock
2. Follow the numbers to fill in the zones with paint. Use light coats and even out ridges with your brush.
3. Paint a second coat as needed.
4. After the paint is dry, cut and fold your place cards.
5. Use a fine tip pen to hand write the names of your guests in the white space on each place card.
