Mainline 4963 Backwater Valve Conversion to Top-Check Backwater Valve

Installation Instructions:

- 1. Remove original valve lid
- 2. Remove existing gate (flip gate up to closed position and click out)
- 3. Remove o-ring located on valve body
- 4. Clean valve body
- 5. Remove gate assembly from Top-Check insert
- 6. Slide Top-Check insert into the throat of the valve inlet side until stop point (if any difficulty sliding in check if solvent cement is present in the throat of the valve; if present try and remove solvent cement)
- 7. Insert floats on each side of the Top-Check insert (with legs facing down). NOTE: valves older than year 2000 may have a leg on the side impeding install of the float to sit flat on the bottom of the valve if present carefully cut float to straddle this leg on each side
- 8. Snap in gate assembly
- 9. Install new lid ensuring red arrow is pointing to the open position bolt lid down (do not overtighten). NOTE: replacing gasket is optional and not required.
 - * Extra nut & bolts supplied in the case installer loses any
- 10. Once installation is complete turn red arrow to ensure the valve gate moves freely and operates properly (return valve to open position)
- 11. Optional: perform a *water test* this can be done by plugging the valve outlet (if supplied, use Mainline Test-Plug). Run house-sold water and the valve should fill with water and eventually close. Ensure both floats activate and rise during the test.
