
Overlap Stair Nose

Installation: Glue - Overlap Stair Nose is glued to the substrate using a high-grade construction adhesive.

<u>Purpose/Application:</u> Overlap Stair Nose is used on stairs with floor planks to complete the stair tread. If you plan to use or make stair risers, you will need to leave enough room for the riser to fit under the stair nose, it is best to install riser first. You can also use stair nosing wherever you have a floor that is raised above the adjoining area. It is best to glue the stair nose using a high-grade construction adhesive, and weight it overnight to insure it will stay firmly attached.

Note: Stairs that have an existing bull nose will need to have the bull nose removed prior to using stair nosing. It is recommended to have this molding before you begin the installation so there are no miscuts.
