


HOW TO KEEP WHAT YOU LOVE

To wash gently. To mend visibly.

To honor fabric as something living, not disposable.

Here's how to make your favorite pieces last—

not just through seasons,

but through time.



LUMINOUS. TEMPERAMENTAL. WORTH EVERY CARE.

SILK

Hand wash quickly in cool water with pH-neutral soap. Swish gently, press out water in a towel, and air dry flat. Steam while still damp, inside out—never iron directly.



SOFT AS MEMORY — IF YOU TREAT IT KINDLY.

WASHABLE SILK

Machine wash on delicate, inside out. Press water out in a towel—never wring. Steam inside out while damp to restore softness and sheen. Avoid heat and friction.



WHISPER-LIGHT WARMTH, WOVEN TO ENDURE.

CASHMERE

Hand wash cold with cashmere-safe soap. Fold in a towel and press—no twisting. Lay flat to dry. Store folded with cedar or lavender to deter moths.



TEXTURED CALM. TIMELESS BY NATURE. RAMIE & LINEN

Wash cool with mild detergent. Shake out and hang to dry for a natural texture, or steam while damp for a smooth finish. Avoid bleach, which weakens fibers.



HANDLE WITHOUT HASTE.

ACETATE


Dry clean recommended. If hand washing, use cold water, minimal soap, and lay flat to dry. Never tumble or apply direct heat-acetate is highly heat-sensitive.




LIKE JEWELRY. CHERISHED, NEVER RUSHED.

BEADED / DELICATE / EMBELLISHED PIECES

Spot clean gently with a damp cloth. Avoid soaking or machine washing. Store flat or on a padded hanger, and consult a specialist cleaner when needed.



Air out between wears. Spot clean sparingly. Dry clean seasonally only if needed. Store folded or hang on a wide, structured hanger—never wire or plastic.



Use a wool cycle or hand wash with wool-safe detergent. Press in towel to remove water. Lay flat to dry and reshape while damp. Store folded to preserve shape.



Steam to release wrinkles and refresh. Spot clean when possible, dry clean only when needed. Hang on wide padded hangers to support structure.



Machine wash cool. Tumble dry low or line dry. Iron inside out if desired. Strong and forgiving, but still benefits from gentle handling.





SUPPLE. SCULPTURAL. MADE TO PATINA WITH YOU.

LEATHER BAGS & APPAREL

Wipe gently with a damp cloth. Condition regularly with pH-balanced cream—Cadillac is our favorite. Store with shape fillers in a breathable space.



Avoid water. Use a suede brush to lift dirt and refresh texture. Treat stains with cornstarch or seek professional suede care. Store with airflow.



Brush gently to lift fibers. Spot clean with woolsafe soap and let air dry—never heat. Store uncompressed to preserve softness and loft.



Wash cool with mild detergent. Avoid fabric softeners—they break down elasticity. Air dry flat to maintain shape and stretch over time.



CARE RITUALS TO REMEMBER

SMALL GESTURES, LASTING IMPACT

WHY IT MATTERS	CARE TIP
Especially for silks—gentler on the fibers.	Steam over iron
Helps restore shape and softness.	Steam while damp
They can distort the garment's natural drape.	Avoid wire hangers
Natural fibers refresh without frequent washing.	Air out often
Allows fabric to rest and rebound between uses.	Rotate wear
