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DISHWASHER / GLASSWASHER STORAGE procedures

If you have been affected by the shutdown, this is the best way to maintain your dishwasher / glasswasher so that it will have less requirement for maintenance when you re-open.

Note: Some models have settings that can purge the chemicals from its lines. You can contact our technical area on 0412 928 370

- 1. Before your last few loads, remove hoses from chemical detergent and rinse aid and place them in a container of clean water.
- 2. Operate the machine as normal, so that the water starts to run through the lines, complete several loads until very little soap is in the wash chamber as the water then cleans out the lines.

Note: Rinse aid is very slow, the main concern is the detergent as it can dry in the lines and solidify, so that when you re-open the lines, they may be blocked and may need to be replaced – try to avoid this.

- 3. Complete the last draining cycle as normal, and clean inside of machine, making sure, all filters and both, the top and bottom filters are cleaned.
- 4. Remove internal filters and drain plugs and leave the door open to air
- 5. Turn off water supply to dishwasher, so that no leaks can occur and turn off power at power point.

This is the best way to ensure that when you can re-open and are ready to set up, the dishwasher can continue to perform.

The dishwasher in your location is one of the best ways you can sanitize many items, its use of a chlorine based detergent and high water temperature does prevent the spread of bacteria.
