Safety and Warnings

Intended Use

NETTA Design is for domestic and indoor use only. This product is not intended for use by people who have lack of experience and knowledge or have reduced ability, or sensory and mental capabilities.

Regular Check-Ups

Ensure the power cable and plug are not damaged before plugging into a socket.

Check all the knobs are functioning correctly.

General Warnings

- Read all instructions.
- Check the voltage of the wall outlet corresponds with the one shown on the rating plate.
- Do not use this product if it has a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance is dropped or damaged in any manner. If the supply cord is damaged it must be replaced by the manufacturer.
- Always disconnect the blender from the supply if it is left unattended and before assembling, disassembling, or cleaning.
- Do not let the cord hang over the edge of a table or surface.
- Do not immerse the upper part of the blender into water and this may cause electric shock.
- Close supervision is needed when the appliance is being used around children.
- The metal blades are extremely sharp. Please handle with care.




Risk of Personal Injury

- Avoid contact with moving parts. Keep hands and utensils out of the container whilst blending to reduce the risk of injury or damage to the blender.
- This appliance should not be used for chopping ice or blending hard and dry substances as this may blunt the blade.
- To reduce the risk of injury, never place the cutting blade on the base without first putting the bowl properly in place.
- Be sure the chopper lid is securely locked in place before operation begins.
- Do not use accessories not recommended by the manufacturer as this may result in personal injury.
- Do not operate the appliance for anything other than its intended use.
- Children should not play with the appliance.
- Before removing the lid from the jar, release the button and unplug the appliance, wait until the blades have come to a complete stop.
- Always remove the blade assembly before pouring contents from the jar.
- Ensure you switch off the appliance after each use. Make sure the motor stops completely before disassembling.
- Always hold the blade stem instead of the cutting edge when handling and cleaning the blade.












Diagram of the Product


Operating the Product

Blender:

- The maximum operation time per use should be less than 1 minute, giving a 3-minute rest time between two consecutive cycles.
- To assemble the detachable shaft with the motor unit, turn the shaft in an anti-clockwise direction until tightened. To disassemble, turn clockwise.
- To use, simply plug the hand blender into a power outlet.
- Lower the blender into the food and then press and hold the low or high-speed button to start operating.
- You can stop the hand blender by releasing the button.

Chopper:

- Maximum operation time per use should be less than 1 minute, giving a 3-minute rest time between two consecutive cycles.
- Place the chopper bowl on a clean and level surface.
- Assemble the chopping blade into the chopper bowl as shown in the figure.





- Place the food into the chopping bowl.
- For meat, remove the bones of the meat, cut into small pieces and then place the meat into the bowl. Do not exceed 200g of meat per blend.
- Attach the lid onto the chopper bowl by pressing it down.
 Detach the lid by lifting it up.
- Insert the motor unit into the hole of the chopper lid.
- Lower the handheld motor into the food and then press and hold the low or high-speed button.
- You can stop the blending by releasing the button.
- When finished, unplug from the power outlet, and then remove the motor unit from the chopper lid by turning it anticlockwise.
- Open the chopper lid by turning it anti-clockwise and remove the chopped food.

CAUTION:

- To reduce the risk of injury, never place the cutting blade on the base without first putting the bowl properly in place.
- Be sure the chopper lid is securely locked in place before operating.
- During operating or after chopping, you should disassemble the motor unit from the chopper lid first and then remove the chopper lid. Never remove the chopper lid with the motor unit still in place.



Whisk/Beater:

- The maximum operation time per use should be less than 2 minutes, giving a 3-minute rest time between two consecutive cycles.
- To assemble, turn the whisk anti-clockwise into the motor unit until tightened. To disassemble, turn it clockwise.
- Plug the hand blender into the mains.
- Place the food (e.g., egg whites) into the cup and lower the blender into the food.
- Press and hold the low or high-speed button to start operating and release when finished.



Cleaning, Maintenance and Storage

- Unplug the appliance and remove the detachable stem.
- Do not immerse the detachable stem of the blender in water as the lubrication on the bearings may wash away over time.
- Wash the detachable stem under running water without the use of abrasive cleaner or detergents. After you have finished cleaning the detachable stem, place it upright so that any water which may have got in can drain out.
- Wash the cup, bowl, beater, and blade in warm soapy water.
 The bowl and beater are not recommended to be washed in a dishwasher as the plastic components deteriorate over time.
- Wipe the motor unit with a damp cloth. Never immerse it in water for cleaning as an electric shock may occur.
- · Dry thoroughly.
- Take care when handling the sharp blades.
- For quick cleaning between tasks, hold the blender in a cup half filled with water and turn on for a few seconds.
