SAFETY & WARNINGS

INTENDED USE

NETTA Design is for domestic and indoor use only. This product is not intended for use by people who have lack of experience and knowledge or have reduced ability, or sensory and metal capabilities. Keep supervised when groups of people use this item.

REGULAR CHECKUPS

- Check cables every time before plugging into a socket, make sure power cables are not burst or snapped and that the power-plug has no damage.
- Check all the knobs are functioning correctly.

GENERAL CAUTIONS

- Always follow this instruction manual and go through all the safety checks.
- This is not toy - do not let children play with it.
- **DO NOT** modify this product in any way.
- Keep work areas clean and well lit.
- Do not operate tools in explosive atmospheres.
- Before using an electric powered appliance, check the rating label and voltage information on this manual, or the rating label on back of the machine.
- Always connect the device to a socket with Residual Current Device (RCD) fitted with your home circuits.
- If you are unsure, please seek a certified election for advice.
- The appliance must not be immersed in liquid.
- Do not use power tools in wet or damp conditions.
- Do not overload your power tools. Match each tool to the task.
- Do not use any power tool if the on/off switch is damaged.
- Check that the moving parts of your tool operate smoothly and are not cracked or damaged.

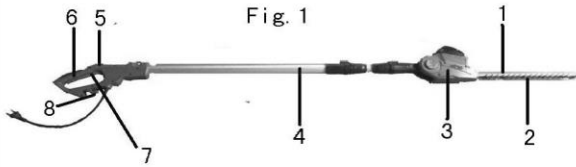

8. Cord Retainer

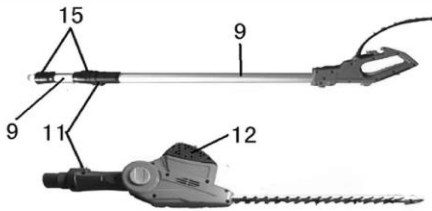

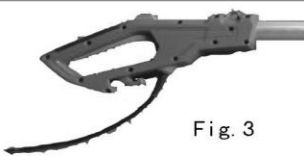

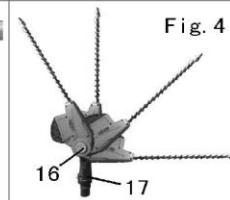

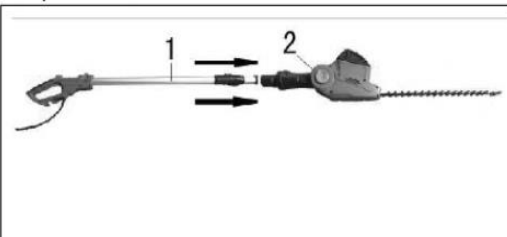

ASSEMBLING THE PRODUCT

Unpack the product and inspect it to ensure no damage has occurred. Do not discard the packaging until you have inspected and operated the item.

ASSEMBLING THE WORKING HEAD TO THE TELESCOPIC POLE

Insert part 1 into part 2, the tubes are egg-shaped and will only install one way. Twist part 3 to lock it into place.

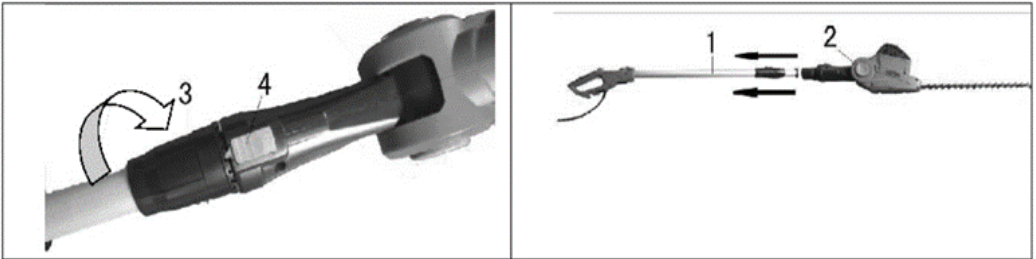


ASSEMBLING THE PRODUCT

EXCHANGING THE WORKING HEAD OF THE HEDGE TRIMMER OR CHAIN SAW

Push part 4, turn part 3 and pull part 1. Connect the needed head as shown in the last section.

You may need to rotate the pole from side to side until it locks into place.



WARNING! Failure to lock the pole as directed could result in injury or death.

This device is only made for cutting and trimming hedges, bushes, and shrubs around your home. This tool is designed for adults. 16+ can use with supervision.

This hedge trimmer should only be connected to a single-phase AC socket outlet. Ensure the mains voltage matches the voltage indicated on the rating plate.

STOPPING AND STARTING THE DEVICE

Connect the hedge trimmer plug to the power supply.

To start the blade movement, push the lock-off button and then pull the switch trigger. To stop, release the switch trigger.

Note: Only use an approved outdoor extension cord when operating this tool.

Grasp the telescopic pole with your left hand the rear handle with your right.

ASSEMBLING THE PRODUCT

ADJUSTING THE PIVOTING HEAD

Disconnect the plug from the power supply and place the hedge trimmer on a sturdy and flat surface.

Push the pivot button and adjust the trimmer head until it snaps securely into place at one of the four positions indicated by the notches.

ADJUSTING THE TELESCOPIC POLE

Disconnect the pole hedge trimmer from the power supply.

Loosen the inner hexagon screw M6X20 with the hex key, push the poles towards each other to shorten the pole or pull away from each other to lengthen the pole.

Note: Extend the telescopic pole only to the length required to reach the hedges being trimmed. Do not extend the handle above waist height. When the desired length is achieved, tighten the inner hexagon screw M6X20 with a hex key. Always keep proper balance.

CUTTING TIPS

Do not force the hedge trimmer through heavy shrubbery.

Do not attempt to cut branches thicker than $\frac{3}{4}$ inch.

If blades become jammed, unplug the device, and allow to stop before touching.

Wear gloves when trimming thorny or prickly growth.

When trimming new growth, use a wide sweeping action so that the stems are fed directly into the cutting blade. Older growth will have thicker stems and will be trimmed easiest by using a sawing movement.

To cut to a set height, you can stretch a piece of string along the desired height of the hedge and trim just above it. Trim the side of the hedge so that it will be slightly narrower at the top. More of the hedge will be exposed when shaped this way, making it more uniform.

OPERATING THE HEDGE TRIMMER

Hold the unit firmly with both hands. Keep your left hand on the telescopic pole and your right hand on the rear handle.

The unit is used for cutting in either direction in a slow, sweeping action from side to side. Stand so that you are stable and balanced on both feet. Inspect and clear the area of any hidden objects.

To protect yourself from electrocution, do not operate within 50ft of overhead electrical lines.

Never use a blade after hitting a hard object without first inspecting it for damage. If damage is detected, do not use the device.

CLEANING & STORAGE

Before carrying out any checks or maintenance operations, disconnect the plug from the electric power supply.

Check your machine regularly before starting work.

Damaged cutting blades must be repaired or exchanged before working with the machine.

After each cutting operation, clean the cutting blade with a soft brush and cloth with lubricating fluid oil and spray a thin layer of fluid protective oil on the blades,

Always keep the ventilation slots in the motor housing clean.

Never clean or spray the machine with water. Clean the motor housing only with a moist cloth and never apply detergents or solvents. These may ruin the plastic parts of the machine. Finally, dry the motor housing carefully.

Store the machine with the supplied protection cover.

Only use the original accessories and spare parts.
