We regularly review known risks that exist in certain geographical regions of the world. We also continuously monitor political contexts that could influence the business and human rights practices in the regions where our suppliers are located.

## Responsibility and Risk Mitigation

We take great care to develop open honest relationships with our suppliers. We have been doing business with many of our suppliers for a decade or more. Strong long-standing relationships better enable us to continuously assess the risk of poor practices by our suppliers that we do not agree with. Based on this ongoing risk assessment we may decide to not deal with specific suppliers or specific countries.
