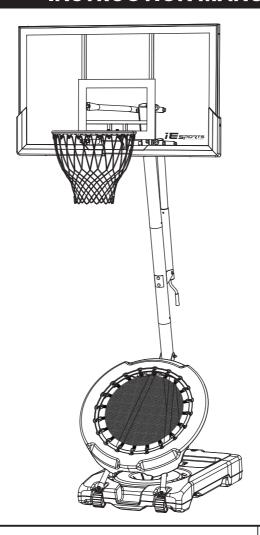

POLE CARE AND SYSTEM MAINTENANCE

The life of your basketball hoop depends on many variables. The climate, exposure to corrosives such as salt, pesticides or herbicides, and excessive use, or misuse can all contribute to product damage, which may cause personal injury. Check your basketball hoop frequently for loose hardware, excessive wear, and signs of corrosion. For safety reasons, and to extend the life of your basketball hoop, you must take the following preventative measures:

- 1. Check all nuts and bolts. If any are loose, tighten them.
- 2. Check all parts for excessive wear and tear. If necessary, replace any parts that have been worn or damaged through usage.
- 3. Check all parts for visible rust, chips, or cracked paint. If any are present, do the following:
 - a) Use an emery cloth to completely remove any rust or chipped paint.
 - b) Clean the area with a damp cloth and allow it to dry.
 - c) Spray two coats of rust preventative, high gloss enamel paint on the area.

IF RUST HAS PENETRATED THROUGH THE POLE ANYWHERE, REPLACE THE POLE IMMEDIATELY!

WARNING!!!

NEVER PLAY WITH THE PORTABLE BASKETBALL SYSTEM WITHOUT FILLING UP THE BASE WITH WATER AND/OR SAND FULLY, AS THE SYSTEM MAY TIP OVER CAUSING INJURIES.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- DO NOT HANG on the rim or any part of the hoop, including backboard, support braces, or net.
- During play, keep the player's face away from the backboard, rim, and net. Serious injury could
 occur if teeth/face come in contact with a backboard, rim, or net.
- Only adults should adjust or move the basketball hoop. When adjusting the height or moving the hoop, keep hands and fingers away from moving parts.
- Always check the unit to ensure that the base is full of water and/or sand, all nuts, bolts and hardware are tight before each use.
- The surface beneath the base must be smooth and free of gravel or other sharp objects. Punctures cause leakage and could cause the device to tip over.
- Do not allow water to freeze in the base if it is full of water.
- Two adults are required to complete the installation.
- Use extreme caution if placing the hoop on a sloped surface. The hoop may tip over more easily.
- Keep this manual for future reference.

To ensure safety, do not attempt to assemble this Basketball Hoop without following the instructions carefully. Check entire box and inside all packing material for parts and/or additional instruction material. Before beginning assembly, read the instructions and identify parts using the hardware identifier and parts list in this document. Proper and complete assembly, use, and supervision are essential for proper operation and to reduce the risk of accident or injury. A high probability of serious injury exists if this Basketball Hoop is not installed, maintained and operated properly.

- If using a ladder during assembly, use extreme caution.
- 2 capable adults are recommended for this operation.
- · Check base daily for leakage. Leaks could cause system to fall.
- Assemble the pole sections properly. Failure to do so could cause the pole sections to separate during play or transport.
- Operational height is 7.5ft (2.28m) to 10ft (3.05m) from the ground to the rim.

Most injuries are caused by misuse and/or not following instructions. Use caution when using this unit.

WARNING TO INSTALLERS

Two capable adults are required for installation. The base MUST be filled with sand and/or water at all times. The entire basketball hoop must be installed according to instructions. Failure to follow instructions could result in SERIOUS INJURY. It is NOT recommended to create a temporary support for the device.

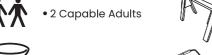




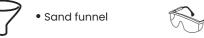
Required Tools And Materials

The following required tools are **NOT INCLUDED**.





• Sawhorse or Support Table (Suggested height is above 32.5 inch)







 Garden Hose or Sand



Wooden Hammer or Rubber Hammer

You can use our free tools for assembly, or you can use your own handy tools.

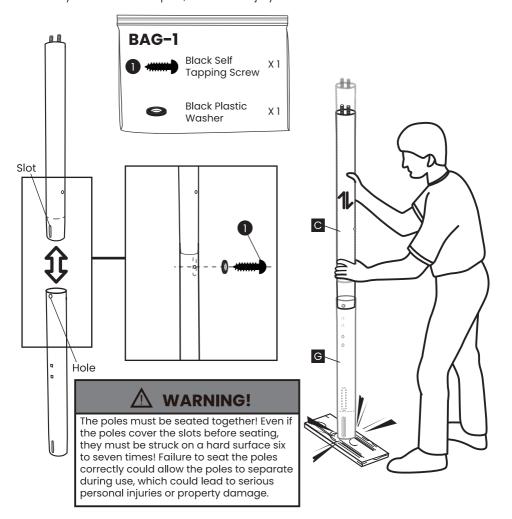
• (2 each) Wrenches and/or Socket Wrenches and Sockets (Deepwell Sockets are Recommended)

Insert Pole (C) into Pole (G). Align the Hole in Pole (G) with the Slot in Pole (C). Install Screw set (1) of **BAG-1** through the Hole and the Slot. Do not tighten the screw at this point. Place the installed pole on a board straight up. Hit the Pole (C,G) on the wooden Board or Thick Cardboard six to seven times. Tighten the screw (1) when the Pole (G) reached the marked line of Pole (C). The marked line is for installation reference only. Hit the poles on a hard surface six to seven times is required.

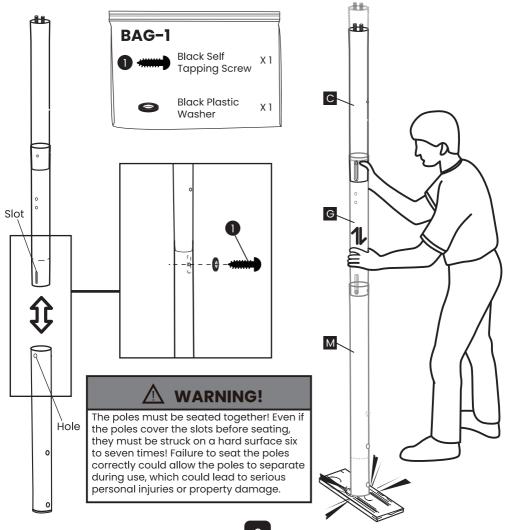
- Ensure the Hole is aligned with the Slot. Failure to do so may result in a slanted backboard.
- Do not hit your feet with the pole, as serious injury could occur.



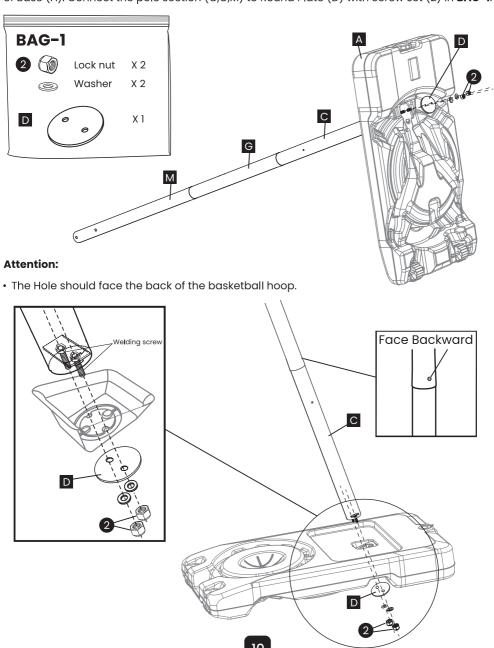
Insert Pole (C,G) to Pole (M). Align the Hole in Pole (M) with the Slot in Pole (C,G). Install Screw set (1) of **BAG-1** through the Hole and the Slot. Do not tighten the screw at this point. Place the installed pole on a board straight up. Hit the Pole (C,G,M) on the wooden Board or Thick Cardboard six to seven times. Tighten the screw (1) when the Pole (M) reached the marked line of Pole (G). The marked line is for installation reference only. Hit the poles on a hard surface six to seven times is required.

WARNING:

- Ensure the Hole is aligned with the Slot. Failure to do so may result in a slanted backboard.
- Do not hit your feet with the pole, as serious injury could occur.

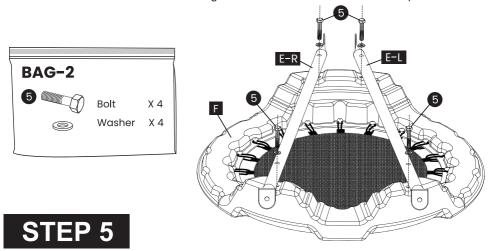


Install the pole section (C,G,M) onto Base (A). Align the two preinstalled bolts through two holes of Base (A). Connect the pole section (C,G,M) to Round Plate (D) with Screw set (2) in **BAG-1**.



Install Bottom Pole Brace (E) on the Rebounder (F) with Screw set (5) in **BAG-2**. Do not tighten the screws at this point.

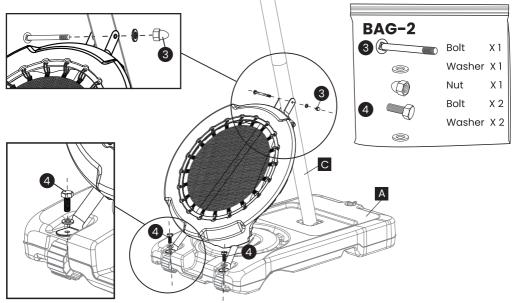
Make sure that the left brace and the right brace are installed in the correct position.



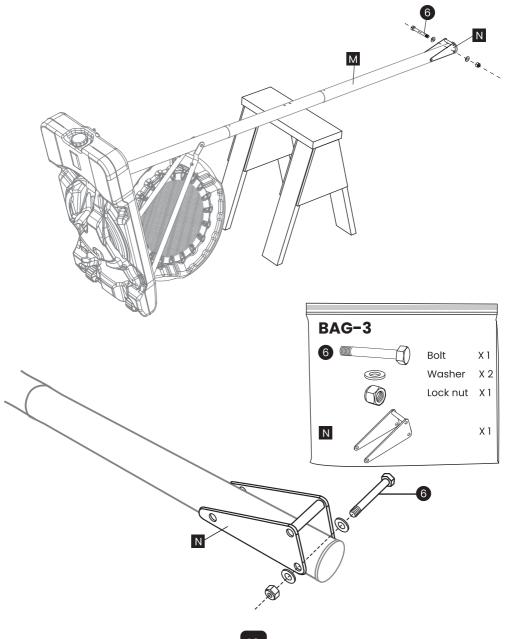
Install the Rebounder onto the base and poles as shown. Connect the Rebounder to Pole (C) with Screw set (3) in **BAG-2**.

Connect the Rebounder to Base (A) with Screw set (4) in **BAG-2**.

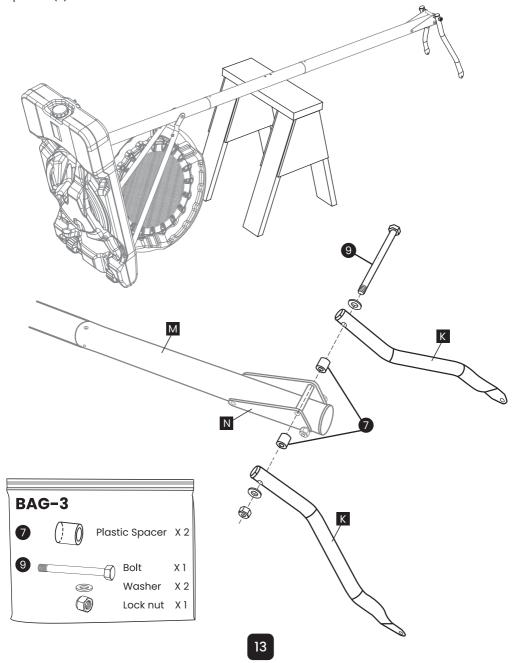
When the Rebounder is in place, tighten all the screws (5) of the Rebounder.

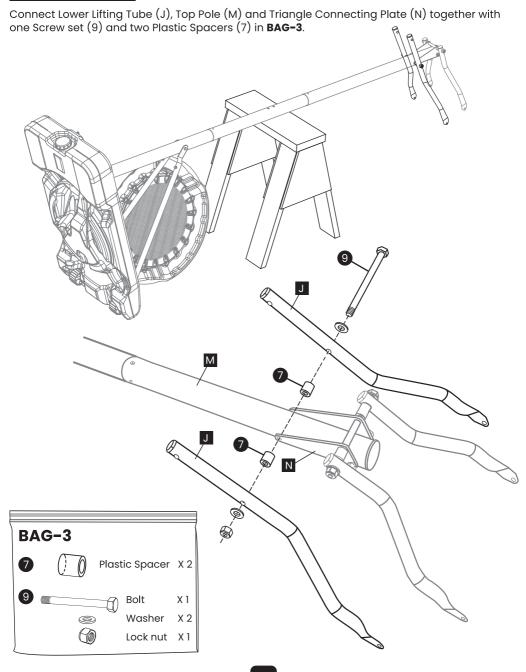


Place the Basketball Hoop base with pole on a sawhorse or a work table carefully. Install the Triangle Connecting Plate (N) to Top Pole (M) with Screw set (6) in **BAG-3**.

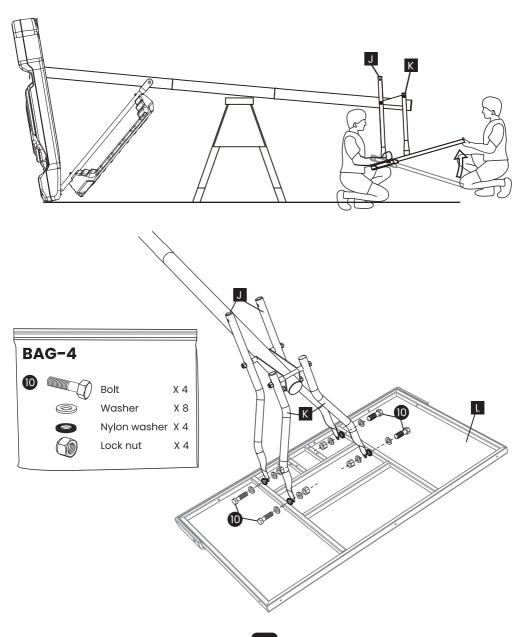


Install the Upper Lifting Tube (K) to Top Pole (M) with one Screw set (9) and two Plastic Spacers (7) in **BAG-3**.





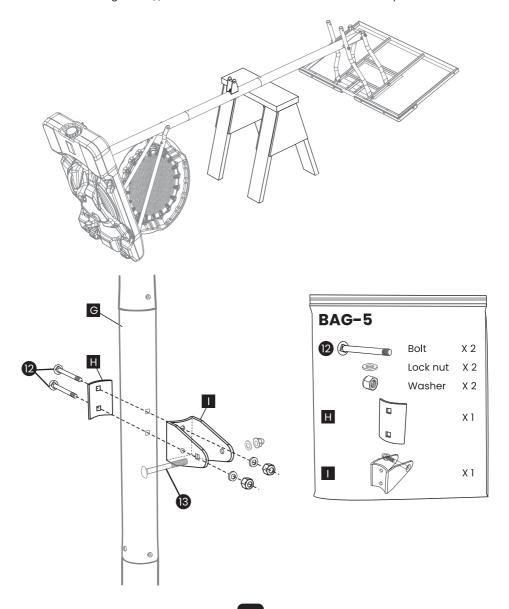
Connect Backboard (L) to Lifting Tubes (J & K) with Screw set (10) in **BAG-4**.



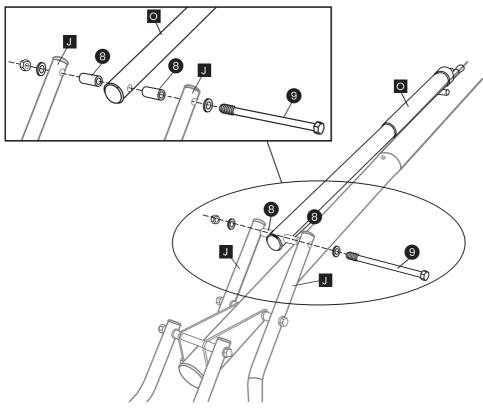
Install Middle Pole Mounting Plate (H) and (I) to Middle Pole (G) with Screw set (12) in **BAG-5**.

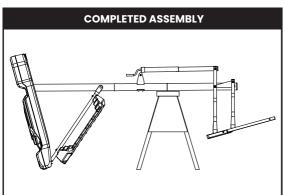

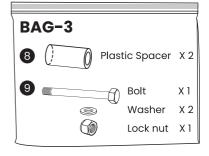
• Middle Pole Mounting Plate (I) should face the back of the basketball hoop.



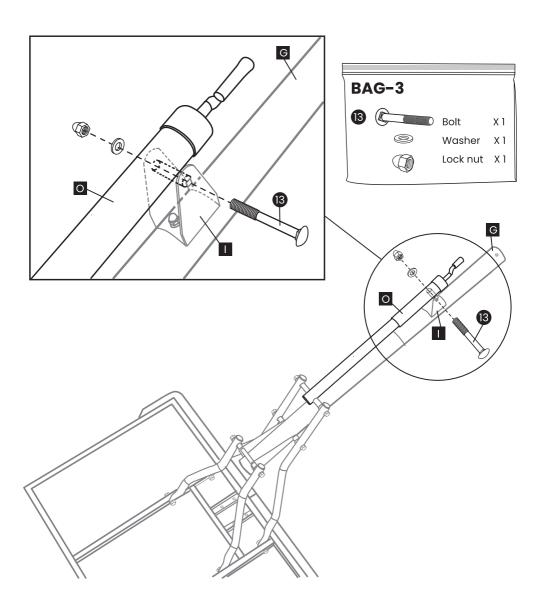
Install the upper part of the Height Adjustment Assembly (O) to the Lower Lifting Tube (J) with one Screw set (9) and two Plastic Spacers (8) in **BAG-3**.



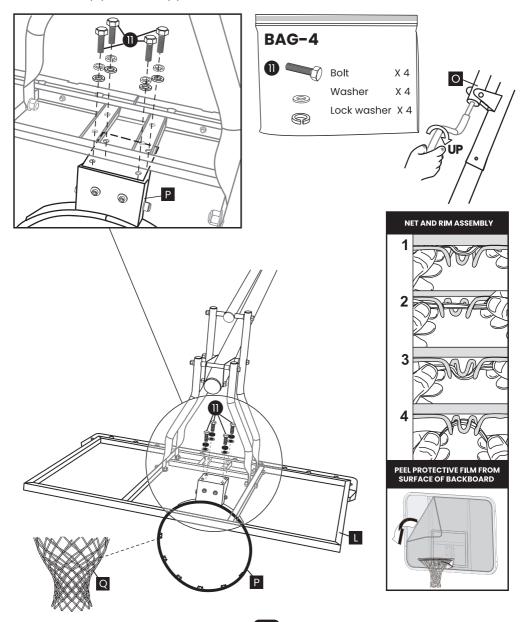




Install the lower part of the Height Adjustment Assembly (O) to the Middle Pole Mounting Plate (I) with Screw set (13) in **BAG-5**.



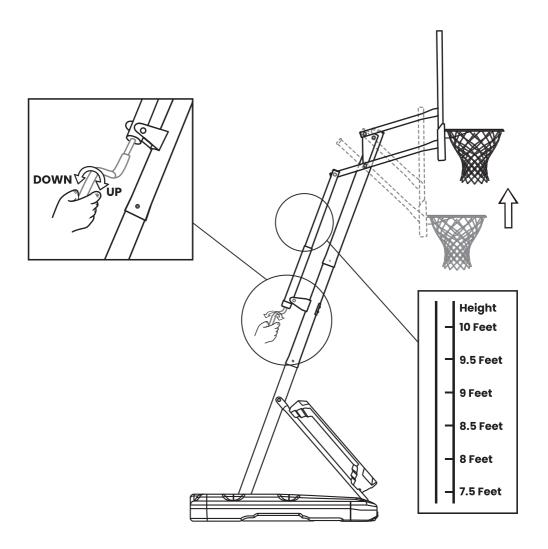
Rotate the Crank Handle of the Height Adjustment Assembly (O) and adjust backboard (L) to 10ft height. Install the Rim (P) to the Backboard (L) with Screw set (11) in **BAG-4**. Install the Net (Q) to the Rim (P) as shown.



Please follow the picture below for height adjustment.

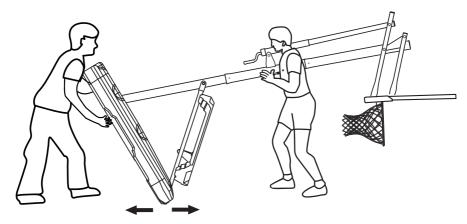
Note:

- Turn the handle clockwise to lift up the backboard.
- Turn the handle counter-clockwise to lower down the backboard.



Moving and Filling the Basketball Hoop

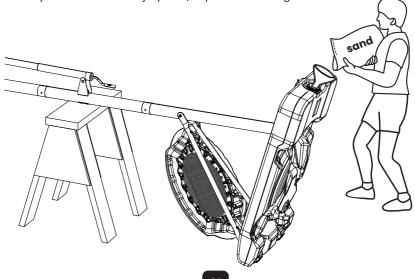
To move the basketball hoop, two adults are required. Lower the backboard to the lowest height. Lift the back of the base up. When the wheels touch the ground, start moving the basketball hoop as shown below.



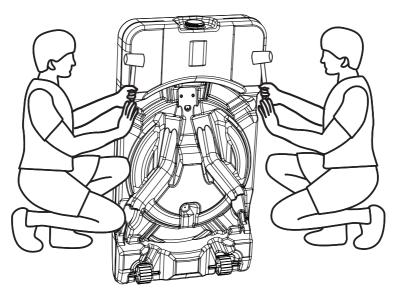
When the basketball hoop is moved to the intended place, place it on a sawhorse or work table carefully. To avoid damaging the Rim during filling, adjust backboard (L) to 10ft height or use a higher support table (above 35 inch). Then start filling the base with sand.

WARNING:

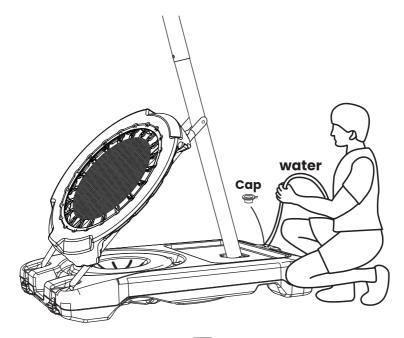
• This Basketball Hoop requires **BOTH Dry Sand and Water** for filling. Failing to follow this instruction may result in serious injury and/or product damage.



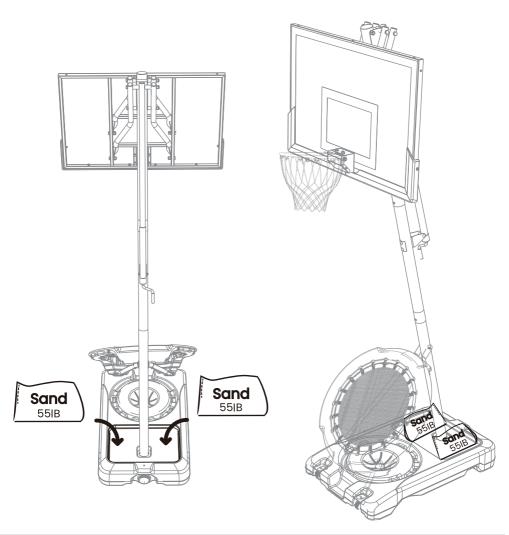
Start filling the base with dry sand first. To make the dry sand reached the bottom of the base easier, gently knock the left and right upper area of the base with a wooden hammer or rubber hammer. 177lb. / 80kg Dry Sand is required for filling.



When finished filling the dry sand, start filling water into the base. 5.3gallon / 18kg Water is ALSO required for filling.



When finished filling both dry sand and water into the base, place the Basketball Hoop upright. Put another 2 bag of 55lb. /25kg sand bag on the base as shown. The basketball hoop is now ready to go.

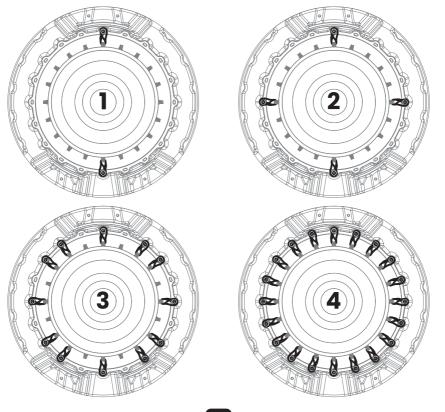

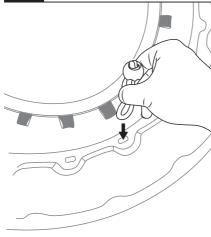

Following the installation order as shown below will make the installation easier and more efficient.





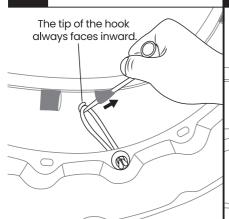


Place the rebounder with the back facing upwards.

Thread the elastic cable tie into the hole of the rebounder.

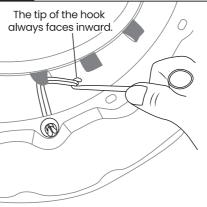
Use the hook and thread it through the mesh fabric loop.

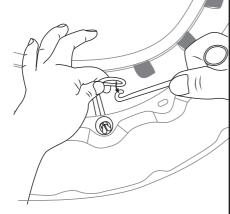


Use the hook and thread the elastic cable tie through the mesh fabric loop.

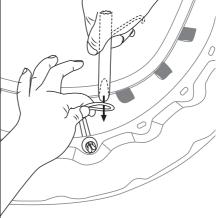
Attention: When pulling the cable, keep the hook tip inward to prevent the hook from scratching the mesh fabric loop when passing through it. 4



Hook the elastic cable tie and pull it through the mesh fabric loop.



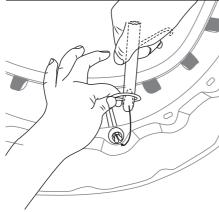
Grab the elastic cable tie that passes through the mesh fabric loop. Then, remove the hook from the elastic cable tie.



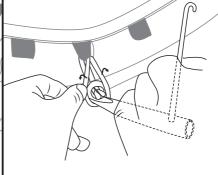
Follow the direction of the arrow, thread the hook handle through the plastic ball on the elastic cable tie.

As shown by the arrow, use the hook handle to pull the elastic loop through the plastic ball at the top of the elastic cable tie.



Pull the hook handle against the plastic ball, press the elastic cable downward.

Let the elastic cable tie slide to the bottom of the plastic ball. Then, remove the hook handle.

Repeat this step to complete the rest of the installation of the elastic cable ties
