

# Patina Stain Variations

## Campania International Palette

Each patina is hand applied in a multi-step process, producing uniquely beautiful and original pieces. The patinas are designed to replicate the look of **naturally aged materials**. Like stain for wood, each piece will accept the patina in varying degrees of intensity, creating natural variations that add character and distinction to each piece.

Due to the hand-application process and photography, **actual colors may vary slightly** from those depicted here.



### **AGED LIMESTONE (AL)**

An antiqued brown with mossy green highlights.



### **ALPINE STONE (AS)**

A rich slate color inspired by natural stone found in the foothills of the Italian Alps.



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**BROWNSTONE (BR)**  
A warm chocolate brown.



**COPPER BRONZE (CB)**  
An aged, oxidized copper.



**ENGLISH MOSS (EM)**  
A vibrant spring green patina that mimics the appearance of real moss.



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**FERRO RUSTIC NUOVO (FN)**  
Mimics the appearance of rusty iron.



**FRENCH LIMESTONE (FL)**  
An off-white cream color that pays homage to the look of natural limestone.



**GREYSTONE (GS)**  
A classic grey patina which gives the look of aged stone.



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## **LEAD ANTIQUE (LA)**

A weathered blue-grey patina inspired by the look of classic antique lead.



## **NATURAL (NA)**

Unfinished concrete. No patina applied.

## **NERO NUOVO (NN)**

A rich black.



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## **PIETRA NUOVA (PN)**

A warm brown with walnut and mahogany undertones.



## **TRAVERTINE (TR)**

A soft honey color, inspired by Roman travertine.



## **VERDE (VE)**

A grey with soft green undertones; warmer than Greystone.
