SET UP INSTRUCTIONS

3454 68" WINGED LION FOUNTAIN

3488 58" MILANO URN LION FOUNTAIN

1. You will need help to set up this fountain.

2. Open the bag containing the pump kit **P29006**. In the kit you will find:

1 - KING 400 (400 gallon pump) 2 - 1/2" plastic tee
1 - 58" long piece of 1/2" clear tubing 1 - 1/2" plastic Y 1 - rubber stopper

3. Find piece of 1/2" clear tubing that is 58" long and cut one piece of this tubing 22" long, one piece 7" long, one piece 6" long and four pieces 4 3/4" long.

4. Find the two 1/2" plastic tees. On the middle connection of the first 1/2" plastic tee attach the piece of 1/2" clear tubing 7" long. On the two end connections of the 1/2" plastic tee attach two of the pieces of 1/2" clear tubing 4 3/4" long. On the middle connection of the second 1/2" plastic tee attach the piece of 1/2" clear tubing 6" long. On the two end connections of the 1/2" plastic tee attach the remaining two pieces of 1/2" clear tubing 4 3/4" long.

5. Find the 1/2" plastic Y. On the end of the 1/2" plastic Y with the single connection attach the piece of 1/2" clear tubing 22" long. On the end of the 1/2" plastic Y with the double connection attach the middle connection of 1/2" plastic tee with the 1/2" clear tubing 7" long on one connection. On the second connection attach the 1/2" plastic tee with the 1/2" clear tubing 6" long. Position the two 1/2" plastic tees perpendicular to each other.

6. Find the pump and attach the opposite end of the piece of 1/2" clear tubing 22" long to the outlet side of the pump.

7. Place the pool on a firm and level area where the fountain will remain. Place a brick or piece of a 2x4 board under one side of the pool to help retrieve the pump power cord from under the pool.

8. Take the pump assembly and set pump in the pump house located in the center of pool. Run the plug end of the power cord down the PVC pipe located in the pump house and out the bottom of the pool. Retrieve cord from under pool and place in groove in bottom of pool. Remove brick or 2x4 board from under pool. Slip the rubber stopper onto the power cord about 12" from the pump with the smaller end facing away from the pump. Insert the rubber stopper snugly into the PVC pipe. Make sure the pump is seated on the bottom of the pump house. Adjust the position of the rubber stopper on the power cord if necessary.

9. Find the plain 15" column base. **You will see that one end of the 15" column base is flat and the other end has a lock to match up with the next piece.** With the flat side down, place the plain 15" column base onto the pump house located in the center of pool. Reach down the center of the 15" column base and locate the tubing assembly that is in the pump house in the center of the pool. Move the end of the tubing assembly with the two 1/2" plastic tee up into the middle of the 15" column base.

10. Find the 15" column center (this is the piece with the four lion heads around it). Place the 15" column center onto the 15" column base located in the center of pool matching up the lock. Reach down the center of the 15" column center and locate the tubing assembly that is in the 15" column base. Trim the tubing to length so it will not kink when attached. Attach the four ends of the tubing assembly to the four lions in 15" column center.

11. Find the 2" column top and place on top of the 15" column center centered. Find the 26" Sitting Winged Lion or the 16" Milano Urn and place on top of 2" column top centered. Find the pump house plug. Place the pump house plug in the square opening in the pump house located in the center of the pool.

12. Fill pool with about 5" of tap water and plug pump into a 110VAC GFCI protected outlet.
