


Installation

1. Hole Drilling





1.1 Draw the center lines




From nished door, measure desired height (950mm as recommended) on door. Stretch it to a horizontal line cross 3 sides of the door. Draw a vertical line on the center of the door edge.

1.3 Drill holes on the door faces




Tips: Drill halfway from each side of the door.

1.2 Mark the positions of all holes according to the template



Tips: Mark the hole positions on the back of door in same way. The hole on the door edge is on the center of door edge.


1.3 Open the hole on the door edge




Note: The part with colour \square should be opened only to a depth of 3mm.







2.1 Install the latch





2.2 Install the front lock body

















- 3.1 Locate the strike plate








Match the strike plate on the latch properly by your hand as the above picture shows. Try closing the door and mark the position of the strike plate on the door frame

Operation Instruction

- 1. Important tips:
- 1.1 The factory defalut master code is "111111". Please change the master code on the initial use refering to 2.5. After the master code is changed, all exit user are deleted automatically.
- 1.2 Carefully keep the override key, take one override key with you and put the spare key in the office or car in order to avoid power failure of door lock.
- 1.3 Sound definiations: One short beep indicates a sound of key pressing; One long beep indicates a successful operations; two short beep (three times) indicates this user is exist; three short beeps a failed operations; four very short beeps indicates low voltage or full voltage.
- 1.4 If a code is wrongly input for 3 times, the keypad is shut down for 10 seconds.
- 1.5 1.5 The lock can store 78 codes and 30 card users.
- 1.6 Do not use corrosive cleaner liquid on lock surface. Clean it with furniture spray wax in time.

2.1.1 Unlocking Door with a Code

Press a valid 6 - digit code Turn the handle

2.1.2 Unlocking Door with a Card

Swipe a valid card Turn the handle


2.1.3 Unlocking Door with an Override key

Use the opener hook to remove the cylinder cover Insert a key into the cylinder, rotate the key






2.3 Enrolling Code User



Note: # can not be used to create a user ID. A user ID is a random 3-digit number. A user code is a random 8-digit number








2.6 Enrolling DIY Card User



Note: # can not be used to create a user ID. A user ID is a random 3-digit number. A code user ID can be same as a card uer ID.






2.9 Enabling/ Disabling Passage Mode




2.10. Reset

Connect the power wire on the front lock body with the batteries. Keep pressing the RESETbutton on the rear metal plate of the front lock body with a small stick for seconds and press any key to wake up the lock. Operation succeeds after hearing a and all its memory is cleared.


2.11 Change the Batteries



Loosen the copper loop with the wrench and remove the back cover.




Replace the old batteries with new one.



Fix the back cover and tighten the copper loop with the wrench.



Change Direction of Front Handle



- Tress down the front handle a little and push up the handle release switch
- ② Rotate the handle to the opposite direction

- ② Rotate the handle to the opposite direction

Solutions for Common Error

Phenomenon	Cause	Solution
Four very short beeps sound when opening the door	Low battery voltage	Change the batteries
No response when pressing the keypad	No battery	Change the batteries
Fail to enter the enrollment or deletion mode	I. The code for enrollment or deletion is not the master code	I.Conrm that you enr oll or delete with the master code

Two beeps sound when enrolling a DIY card user	The card was once registered	Change an empty card to register
