

# Jolly Santa Plate

## **Supplies:**

- Paper plate
- Tan, white, light pink and black paint
- Paint brush
- White and red construction paper
- Craft glue
- Pen or pencil
- Small wooden dowel
- Cotton balls
- scissors



1. Place an old piece of newspaper onto your craft surface before you start. Paint your plate with the tan paint and let dry. Paint a second coat if needed and let it dry.
2. Draw a large hat onto your red paper and cut out with scissors. Carefully glue the back of your hat to the top of the plate.
3. Use your fingertips to paint on your white circle eyes below the hat, light pink circle cheeks and a pink oval nose. Allow to dry.
4. Glue cotton balls to the rim and point of the hat.
5. Cut your white paper into ½” strips and wrap each strip around the wooden dowel to curl it.
6. Glue one curl to the bottom of the plate under the nose, making sure the curl side is facing up.
7. Cut 1” off two strips and glue them to each side of the middle strip.
8. Cut 1” off two more strips and glue to the side of the pieces you just glued. Continue with this until Santa’s face has a full beard.
9. Open and spread out cotton balls and glue under the nose.
