Paper Bag Witch

A fun and easy Halloween craft your kids can make to decorate your house with!

Supplies:

- Paper lunch bag
- Small paper plate
- Black and lime green paint
- Black, orange and lime green construction paper
- Googly eyes
- Marker
- Scissors
- Glue
- Stapler



- 1. Start by painting the front of your paper lunch bag with black paint, and the bottom of your small paper plate with lime green paint. Set them aside to dry completely.
- 2. Trace your child's hands onto your orange construction paper and cut them out. You will also need a nose cut out of the green construction paper, and a witch hat from the black construction paper.
- 3. When your paper plate is dry, cut a slit out of each side of the plate to give your witch a big chin. Staple it to the bottom of your paper bag.
- 4. Fold the fingers of the handprints accordion style to make your witch's hair curly. Staple each handprint onto your paper plate for the hair. Then staple your witch hat at the top of the paper plate.
- 5. Finish your witch by gluing on your googly eyes and nose and drawing a mouth with your marker.
