- 1 REEF Mat
- 1 High Capacity Hand Pump
- 1 Storage Bag
- 1 Repair Kit (*Glue not included)
- 1 Valve Wrench

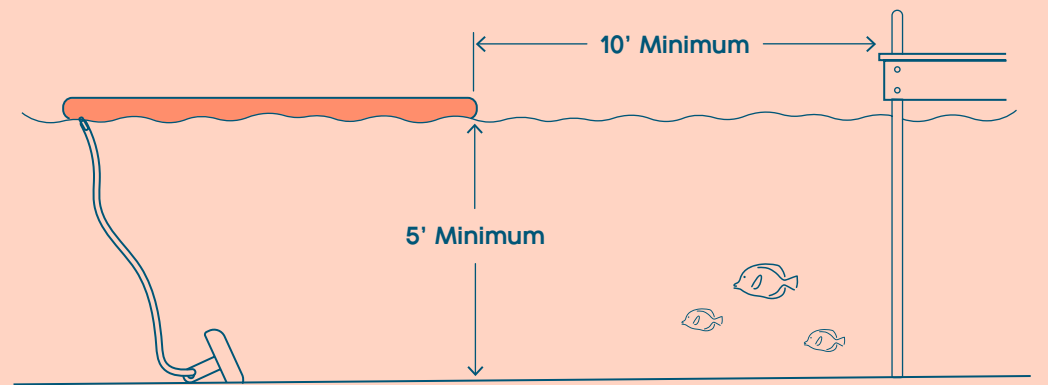


THE BIG PICTURE.

All you need, in a glance.

- Never drag! Inflated or deflated.
- Use pump in dual action mode.
- Inflate to 4 PSI.
- Use in deep water away from hard objects.
- D-ring goes down.
- Flat fold mat. Never roll.
- ALWAYS store deflated mat in bag.

Deployment



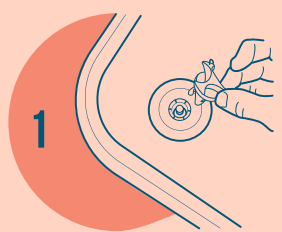
Float at least 10 feet away from any hard surfaces.

Use the D-ring to secure the mat in water deeper than 5 feet.

Check safety warnings for additional precautions.

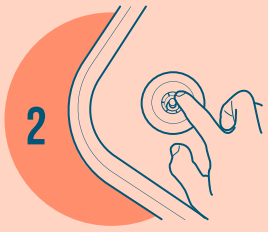
Inflation

For faster inflation, start with the pump in "Double Action" mode. If it becomes difficult to pump, switch the lever over to "Single Action."



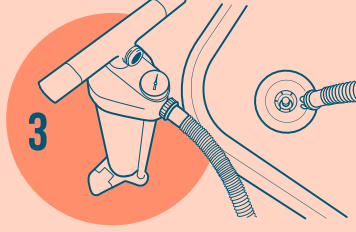
Lay flat with valve up. Remove cap.

*Avoid rough surfaces like driveways



Click the valve stem up to ensure that it is closed.

*If it is not closed, air will escape when the hose is removed.



Attach the hose to the **INF** port on the pump.

Insert hose into the valve and turn clockwise to lock.



Inflate to desired pressure.

- 2-3 PSI - a softer feel for 1-3 users
- 4 PSI - a preferred pressure
- 5-8 PSI - a firmer feel or more users

*DO NOT INFLATE BEYOND 10 PSI

FAQ

Why are there white marks on the fold lines when unrolling for the first time? This is normal. They'll disappear after exposure to the sun.

What should I use to clean my REEF?

- Clean with mild soap and water as necessary. Never use solvents or abrasive cleaners.
- MISSION Vinyl Cleaner is the perfect cleaner for your mat.
- Never use a pressure washer to clean the mat. Permanent damage will occur.

Why is my valve leaking air?

It's most likely a loose valve. Use the included valve wrench to tighten.

Storage

Always store your deflated mat in bag.

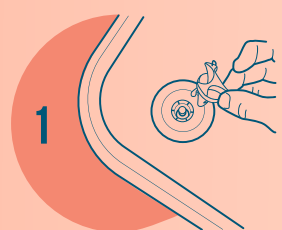
Never drag on concrete or hard surfaces.

WARNING: Creased edges of folded mat are vulnerable to damage.

Store mat in bag in a cool, dry location protected from sharp objects and critters.

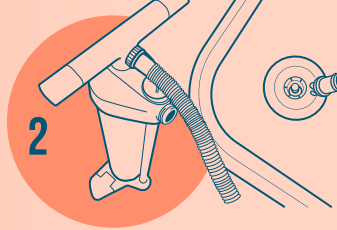
For long term storage: Be sure to completely dry your mat with a soft cloth to prevent mold and mildew.

Deflation

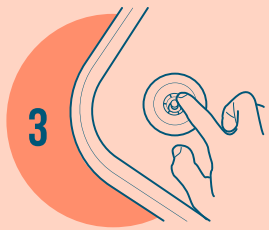


Remove cap. Click the valve stem down to open valve.

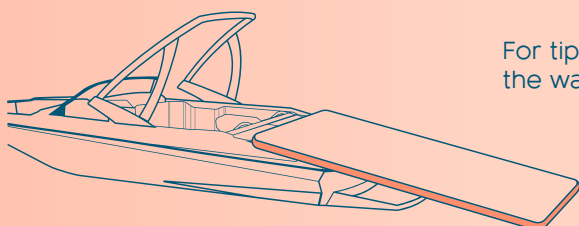
*Avoid rough surfaces like driveways



To fully deflate, attach hose to pump using **DEF** port. Use "double action" setting for fast deflation.

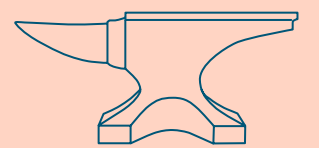
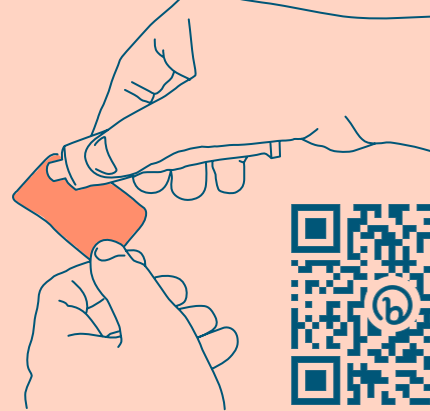


Click the valve stem up to close valve. This keeps mat deflated for best fold.

Repair



To repair your mat with a patch, apply consistent weight while patch dries.



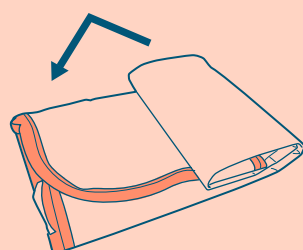
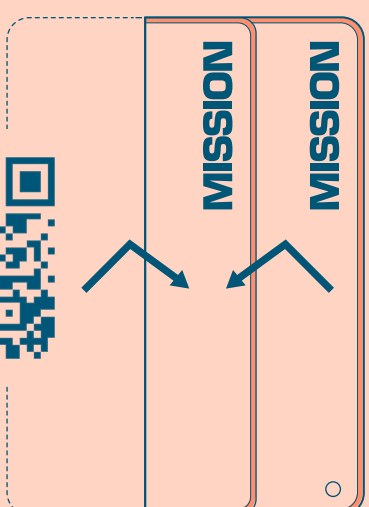
Need to make a repair? Bummer. But don't worry, we'll walk you through it.

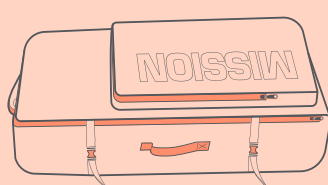
Allow 24 hours for patch to cure.

Folding



Flat fold mat. Never Roll.



ALWAYS store deflated mat in bag.

To reduce risk:

Read and understand all of the information contained in this instruction booklet before inflation and use.

Always wear an appropriate U.S. Coast Guard-approved personal flotation device (PFD) when using REEF on the water.

Never swim under REEF. REEF does not allow resurfacing for air while beneath it.

REEF is not a lifesaving device. Use only under adult supervision.

REEF is not designed for towing.

Never tow REEF with any person on it for any reason.

Contact with the D-ring can cause injury. Always position REEF with D-ring side down.

Never use REEF under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

Never jump or dive head first from REEF and always enter water feet first.

Never attach REEF to any object using both handles - this could create an entrapment danger.

Do not use REEF as a slide from other objects. Collision and injury could occur.

REEF is intended to be used in large bodies of water with a minimum depth of 5 feet.

Always maintain at least 10 feet of separation between REEF and other objects to avoid collision injury.

Always inspect water depth and bottom conditions before use and ensure area is free of hazards.
