




THE STAIR BARRIER®

Banister to Banister (BB) Installation Instructions



Package contains:
1 Stair Barrier (BB)
NO TOOLS REQUIRED

Secures stair widths:
Regular BBR: 32" tall;
fits openings 36" to 42" wide

Wide BBW: 32" tall;
fits openings 42+ to 52" wide



BEFORE INSTALLATION


To properly install, use, and enjoy the Stair Barrier, you need to know the staircase terms shown in the diagram below.

Before installation of the Stair Barrier, measure the distance between the Banisters at the bottom of your Staircase and confirm that you have purchased the correct Stair Barrier model.



DIRECTIONS

1. While facing your staircase, position the front of the Stair Barrier between the banisters at the bottom stair.
2. Position the Stair Barrier as far to the rear of the tread as possible. If there are multiple spindles on the tread where the Stair Barrier is to be installed, use the spindle located closest to the rear of the tread. **See Fig. 3.**
3. Thread the top left strap of the Stair Barrier around the left banister and latch the buckle. Next, thread the top right strap of the Stair Barrier around the right banister and latch the buckle. You may use the banister, spindles, or both to attach the straps. In some cases, you may choose to use multiple spindles. **See Figs. 1, 2 and 3.**
4. Repeat this process for the middle and bottom straps.
5. Tighten all straps so that the Stair Barrier is taught.
6. As shown in **Fig. 4**, when properly installed, the sides of the Stair Barrier should be flush with the banisters or spindles—there should be no gaps. The bottom edge of the Stair Barrier should be flush with the tread—there should be no gap.
7. If one side of the Side Barrier is unlatched to allow access to the staircase, completely roll the Stair Barrier to the side that is still attached to the banister. **See Fig. 5.** When not in use, the Stair Barrier should not block the staircase. **See Fig. 6.**




⚠️ WARNING

Children have died or been seriously injured when gates and/or enclosures are not securely installed. **ALWAYS** install and use The Stair Barrier as directed using all required parts. Read all warnings and instructions before installation. **NEVER** attempt to step over The Stair Barrier. To prevent falls, **NEVER** use at top of stairs. **NEVER** use to keep child away from pool. Use only with the latching mechanisms securely engaged—only use with all buckles latched and all straps tight and secure. **NEVER** use The Stair Barrier without its internal struts. For use with children 6 months to 2 years of age and/or pets. Proper adult supervision is required—never leave any child unattended. **STOP** using when a child can climb over or dislodge The Stair Barrier. The Stair Barrier will not prevent all accidents. Misuse may cause serious injury or death.


⚠️ CAUTION

Internal Struts must be installed during use. Do not remove Internal Struts, except to clean. Always latch Buckles during use. Always adjust all Straps to ensure tight fit.

When one side of the Stair Barrier is unbuckled to allow access to the staircase, completely roll the Stair Barrier to other side of the staircase with Straps and Buckles rolled internally. See Fig. 5 above.



CLEANING AND CARE



All **indoor** Stair Barriers are made of Class 1 Upholstery grade fabric. Cleaning code is "S". To clean, use a soft brush to loosen dirt and then vacuum the Stair Barrier with an upholstery attachment. For tougher stains, use a mild water-free solvent or dry-cleaning product. If dry cleaning is necessary, remove the Internal Struts prior to cleaning, **See Fig. 7**. Reinstall the struts prior to use.

The **Indoor/Outdoor** Stair Barriers are made of weather resistant fabric. For spot cleaning: use a damp cloth to remove any dirt.

For difficult or large stains; first remove internal plastic struts, **See Fig. 7**. Lay Stair Barrier on a flat surface and wet fabric with water. Use a solution of warm water and mild dish soap along with a soft bristle brush to clean and remove stains. Thoroughly rinse off all soap residue and air dry. Do not machine wash, dry clean, or pressure wash. Reinstall the struts prior to use.

LIMITED WARRANTY

Better Options LLC will activate this limited warranty upon receipt of your Warranty Registration Card. Alternatively, to register on-line, visit www.thestairbarrier.com.

After activation, Better Options warrants the Stair Barrier to be free from defects in material and workmanship for a period of 1 year from the date of original retail sale. This limited warranty is valid only for the first retail consumer. Proof of purchase is required.

If Better Options determines that the Stair Barrier is defective in material or workmanship during the warranty period, Better Options shall, at its sole option, repair or replace the Stair Barrier with a similar product or replacement part(s) (collectively, "replacement unit"). This is the sole remedy. Any replacement unit shall be covered by the balance of any time remaining under this limited warranty.

The limited warranty does not cover deterioration or malfunction resulting from normal wear and tear, improper maintenance, misuse, modification, neglect, abuse, and/or repairs, or attempted repairs, made by anyone not authorized by Better Options LLC.

To obtain warranty service, you must contact Better Options to make a claim within thirty (30) days after you discover a problem. To fully evaluate your claim, Better Options may ask that you send, at your expense, pictures of the Stair Barrier and/or the product itself.
