



1. Plant in 6 or more direct hours of Sunlight.
2. Dig hole 15" deep and 18" wide.
3. Use #1 Baccto Rose Mix to amend soil.
4. Remove rose from its container and hold it in the hole so the top of the soil ball is at ground level. Make sure the plant is placed at the same depth it was previously growing in the container.
5. Fill the hole with the prepared soil mixture. Water the plant well to allow the backfilled soil to settle around the root ball. Add more soil if necessary.
6. Fertilizer with #2 Rose Tone in Mid-April; second application in late May; third application late July.
7. Deneweth's recommends using #3 Bayer Advanced Rose and Flower Care for Systemic Insect control, Disease Control & Systemic fertilization. Please Use Label Rates.
