It is advised to give your pet nutritional variety by rotating proteins, as each protein will vary in nutrients. For example, pork is the richest source of Vit B1, where beef and poultry have it in lower amounts. If you feed the same protein for months, supplementation is necessary to prevent deficiencies. At the very least, we recommend rotating proteins monthly. However, most raw feeders will rotate as frequently as every meal or every few days.

Add-ins: Krill oil or green-lipped mussels (fresh or freeze-dried), egg yolks, well-sourced sardines, mushrooms or mushroom extracts (like MycoDog), & kelp powder are great to rotate into your pet's bowl for additional health benefits and to bridge any nutrient gaps.

This is a boar grind which includes the essential meat, organ, and bone in a prey model ratio (80/10/10) that is closest to that of the animal, the 10% organ is broken down into 5/5.
