Care and Cleaning Instructions

Our marble surfaces display the unique markings and color variations of pure, unfinished stone. Clean on a regular basis. Rinse out your sponge or cloth with plain hot water and wipe away any residue from the surface. If you have streaks and a dull finish, it may be because there is still soap residue on the surface. Rinse the sponge or cloth again with hot water and wring it out thoroughly to remove most of the excess water. Wipe over the surface again to remove any residue. As a natural material marble & travertine are sensitive to liquids and if not removed immediately, spilled liquids will leave a permanent stain on the unit.

This product ships assembled.

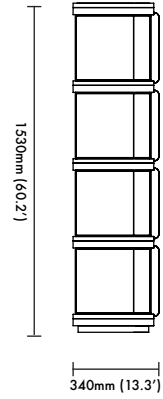
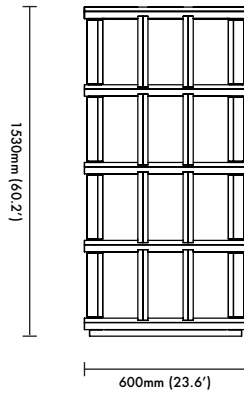
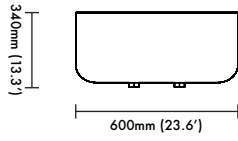
Barboure Unit
