We have reviewed incidents that we believe necessary to review, and have penalized the following:

1.

Drivers Involved: #738 Marcelo Reales, #1 Aaron Vasquezz, #84 Ayrton Reutemann

Race: AMX10 - Race 5 - Heat 1

Lap: 4

Outcome: P1 for #738 Marcelo Reales (3 Second Post-Race Penalty)

Regulation: 5.5.4. Car Contact

#738 Marcelo Reales failed to maintain safe distance of #1 Aaron Vasquezz, and made contact with him, which led Vasquezz to crash into #84 Ayrton Reutemann. Car contact deemed to have been possible to avoid.

Drivers Involved: #1 Aaron Vasquezz, #27 Gaston Kulhavy, #738 Marcelo Reales

Race: AMX10 - Race 5 - Heat 2

Lap: 1

Outcome: P1 for #1 Aaron Vasquezz (3 Second Post-Race Penalty)

Regulation: 5.5.3. Overtaking Protocol

#1 Aaron Vasquez attempted to overtake aggressively, entering the corner too fast on the inside and colliding with #27 Gaston Kulhavy and #738 Marcelo Reales.

Drivers Involved: #21 Simon De Mori

Race: AMX10 - Race 6 - Heat 1

Lap: 3

Outcome: P1 for #21 Simon De Mori (3 Second Post-Race Penalty)

Regulation: 5.5.4. Car Contact

#21 Simon De Mori failed to maintain a safe distance from #12 Kieran Harrison, resulting in contact that escalated into a larger incident, causing #12 Kieran Harrison to exit the race. This situation could have been avoided.

Drivers Involved: #15 Jackson Resende, #17 Gael Valero, #6 Roman Pascucci

Race: AMX ONE - Race 6 - Heat 1

Lap: 4

Outcome: P1 for #15 Jackson Resende (3 Second Post-Race Penalty)

Regulation: 5.5.4. Car Contact

#20 Pedro Moura attempted to pass #7 Nico Godoy but lacked sufficient space and speed to complete the maneuver, resulting in contact that caused #7 Nico Godoy to spin.
