

Evora Cove Candle Making Workshop Liability Waiver

Risks associated with Evora Cove Candle Workshops:

Hot Materials and Equipment:

- Working with melted wax, pouring pots, and other equipment at high temperatures (potentially up to 85°C) poses a risk of burns and injuries if not handled with caution.
- Hot tools such as spoons and candle jars can cause burns if touched without proper care.

Allergic Reactions:

- Exposure to fragrance oils and other materials used in candle-making may lead to allergic reactions or skin irritations. Participants should be aware of their allergies and take necessary precautions.

Fire Hazard:

- The use of open flames, such as wicks and heating elements, presents a risk of fire. Participants should follow safety guidelines to minimize the risk of accidental fires.

Chemical Exposure:

ALCOHOL: If consuming alcohol, I confirm that I am over 18, will drink responsibly, and assume all associated risks. I affirm that I have arranged for transportation or designated a driver if impaired. Evora Cove reserves the right to approve BYOB events, may request ID, and deny access to individuals under 18.
