



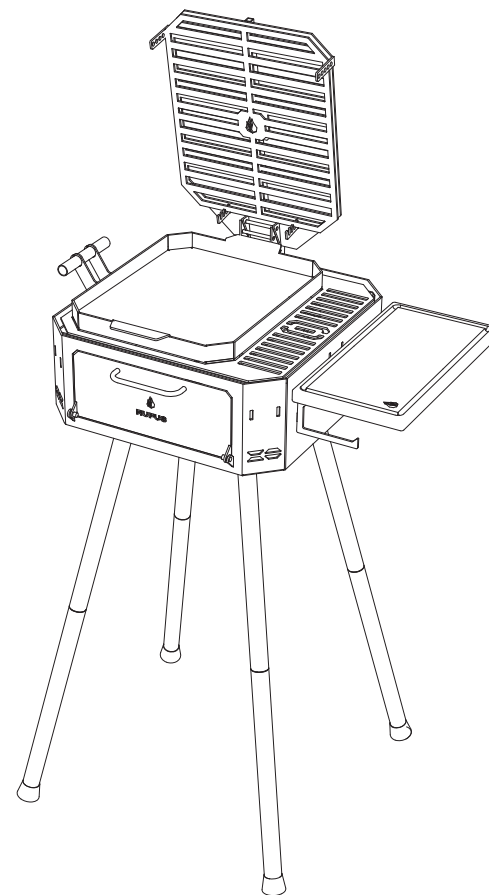
Ready to use? Just remember the following:

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Curing

Prior to the first use of the grill, unpainted parts must be cured. This is a simple process that consists of 3 steps and requires 3 elements:



1. Cooking oil
or grease



2. Cloth
or paper



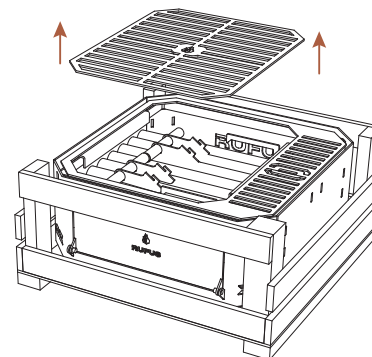
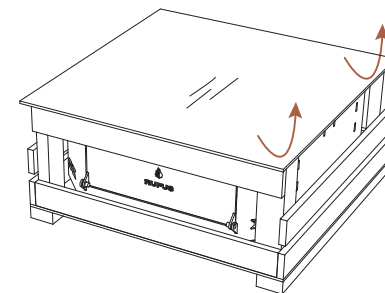
3. Heat source

- 1 Wash the iron piece before beginning the curing process.
- 2 Apply a thin film (small amount) of oil on the material, spread it well with the paper, and then clean the piece with a dry cloth.
- 3 Expose the piece to the heat of the stove, oven or direct flame for a few minutes or until you notice that the material begins to darken.

Repeat last two steps if necessary

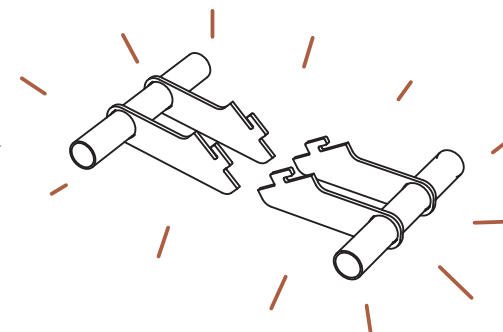
Opening

- 1 Product arrives like this, on a wooden box. Proceed to remove the lid.



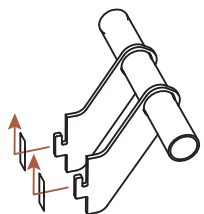
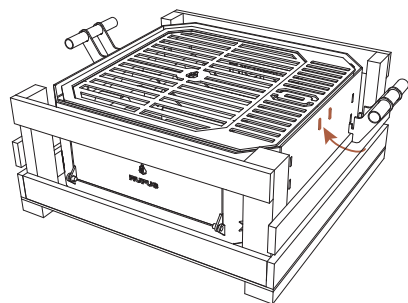
- 2 Continue taking out grill and pick up the handles.

- 3 This are the handles that would help unbox on next step.

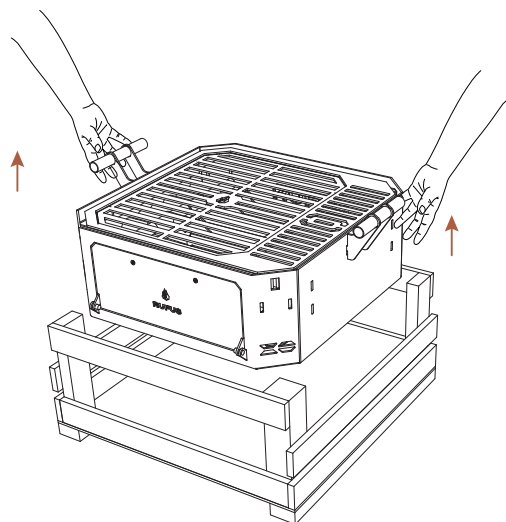


Unboxing

- 1 Check how handles are mounted over sides of the Zonda.



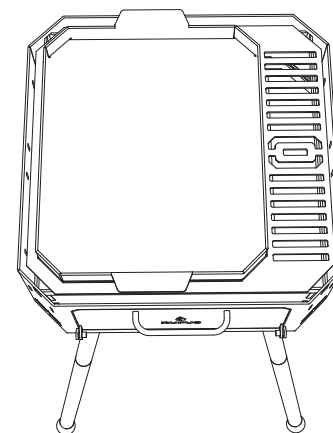
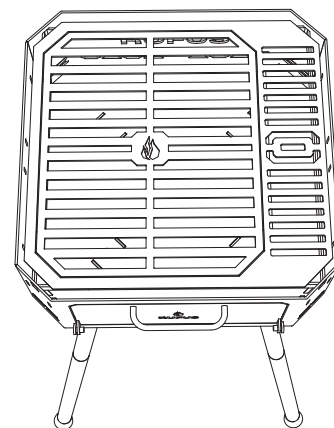
- 2 Please notice that there are specific slots to fit the handle.



- 3 Hold the handles tight once they are in place and pull up.

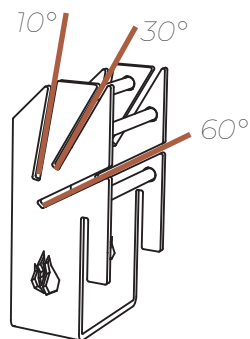
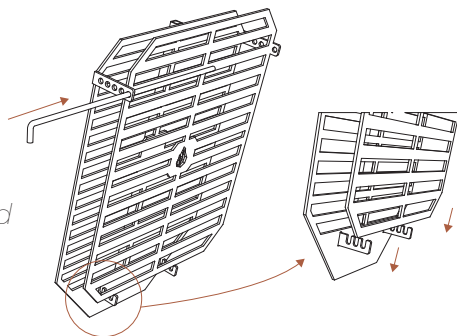
Griddle & Grills

- 1 The use of the grill or the griddle are the choice of each cook.



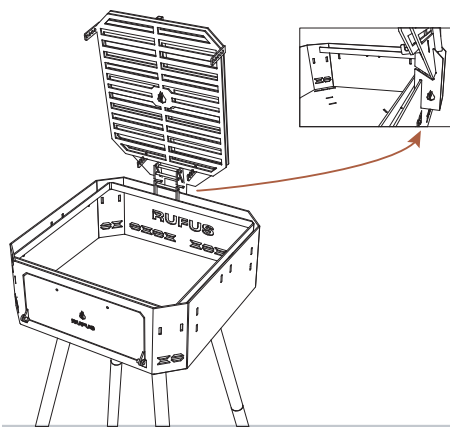
Clamp Rack

- 1 The clamp rack works as a press. You need one of the product's grills, it must first be placed underneath and then closed with the rod.



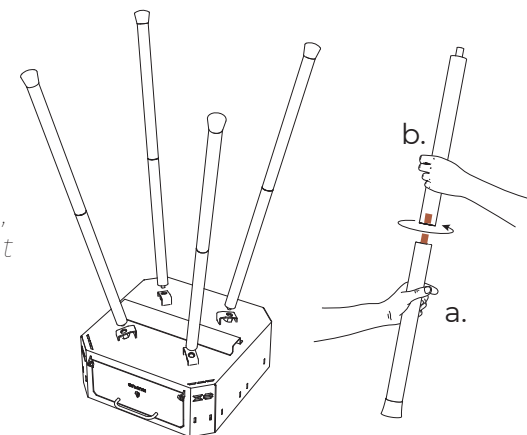
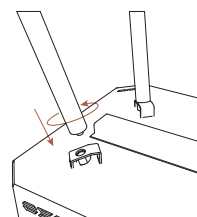
- 2 It can be used in 3 different positions depending on the thickness of the food being pressed. And heat needed.

- 3 You can mount cross wherever you want over the side of the Zonda, just double check that it stands firm.



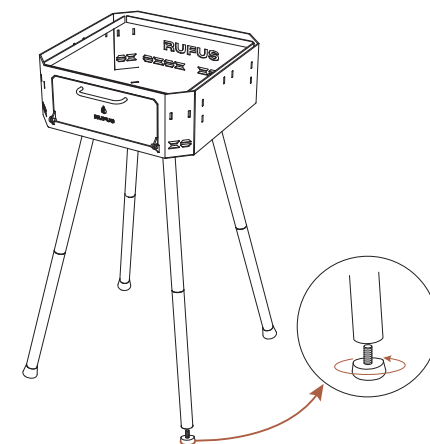
Legs assemble

- 1 Face down Zonda and then, one by one, grab and mount the legs. Check legs are first screwed in one piece (a & b).



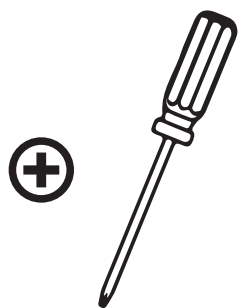
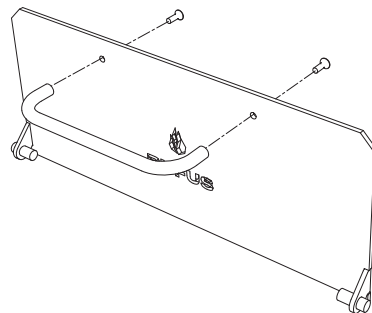
- 2 Each leg needs to be screwed into a nut.

- 3 Notice there is one leg that has a adjustable ferrule, for fixing Zonda onto irregular surfaces.



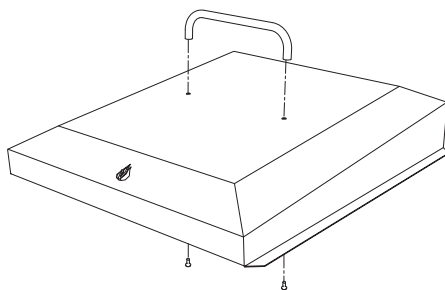
Aluminium Handle

- 1** There is one aluminium handle screwed inside the door, you need to unscrew it and place it on the outer side.



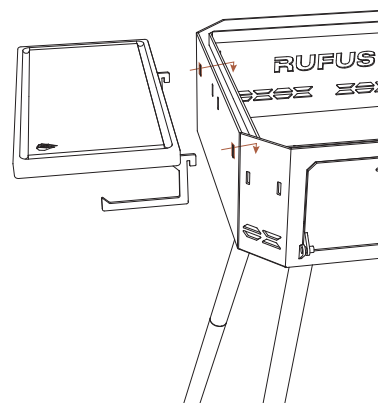
- 2** Use correct Phillips screwdriver for operation.

- 3** You will need to do the same process for the smoker lid.

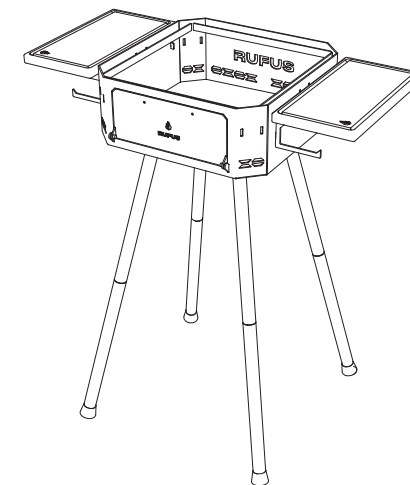


Board & Cross

- 1** The wooden board can be mounted either on right or left hand of the grill.



- 3** Below the board are the "arms" where you can place the shovel and/or poker at rest.



- 2** Use the specific slots for this step.
