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- Secure the stencil with Masking tape or low-tack adhesive, to prevent its movement.
- Pick up some wet mediums (like Paint, Inks) on Stencil Brush or Sponge or Foam.
- Tap off excess medium on paper towel. Now apply on stencil
- ♠ Apply colors in different shades and highlight them if necessary. Allow drying time between applications
- Use gentle swirling or tapping motions to prevent the mediums from seeping underneath.
- Once done, remove stencil by Lifting gently up one corner.



Inks, Paints, Sprays, Texture Paste, Embossing Paste, Embossing powders Air Brushing, Glittering, Bleaching, Stamping, Doodling, Dry Embossing.

Care:

Wash the stencils immediately after use. Clean them with Soap water Some Inks may stain the stencil, but will not affect its performance




Supplies Used:

- Short Drinking glass
- **★** Folk Art Color Spray paint : Yellow, Bright Green
- Folk Art Acrylic Paint Licorice
- Stencil Brush / Sponge
- **★** Varnish
- Tea Light Candle

Instructions:

- 1. Clean the glass thoroughly and spray it withFolkArt paints Yellow and Bright Green.Let it dry for 2 hours.
- 2. Now secure the Choose Joy stencil on the glass with low tack adhesive. Make sure it is bent and is tightly fixed over the curves of glass. This will prevent paint seepage.
- 3. Apply Licorice paint with stencil brush on the design. Leave it to dry for 15 minutes and then remove the stencil.
- 4. Varnish the glass completely 2-3 times.
- 5. Now place the Tea Light Candle inside and beautiful Tea Light Holder is ready!!
- 6. You can use CrafTreat Stencil CTS376 Choose Joy.

Pecorated Paper Bags

Spruce up your boring Paper Bags and make them beautiful!! They will make Great Personalized gift bags for any occasion.





- Paper Bags White and Kraft
- Borders
- Stencil Brush/Sponge

- 1. Place a Cardstock or parchement paper inside the bag, to prevent the paints seeping to the other side.
- 2. Choose your paint color and apply it through stencil onto the bag, by gently tapping with a stencil brush/sponge.
- 3. Change colors and do masking wherever necessary.
- 4. Continue till you are satisfied! Add bling, pearls, stickles..etc and sentiments to your liking
- 5. You can decorate a whole bunch of bags in very less time and use it whenever needed.



Paints of your choice can be used. Similarly Fabric Pencil Pouches, Purses can be decorated.





Stenciled Scarf / Stoles

- **★** CrafTreat Stencil CTS108 Kokopelli
- **★** FolkArt Fabric Paint − Licorice
- Stencil Brush/ Sponge

- 1. Stretch the scarf tightly on table
- 2. Secure the Stencil on the scarf with tape.
- 3. Apply Paint through stencil on the scarf
- 4. Once done, move it to the next position and repeat the same procedure.
- 5. Wear your scarf and show off!!

Colors are the Language of Smiles. Colors bring Joy, Love and Laughter!! So,why not give some one a Rainbow card? The Best part is you can make it for Any Occasion and in a Jiffy!!



Supplies Used:

- CardStocks
- **CrafTreat Stencils CTS069 Checkered,** CTS005 Ikat Chevron, CTS011 Aztec Borders, CTS039 Warli
- Distress inks Seedless Preserves, Salty Ocean, Mowed Lawn, Mustard Seed, Spiced Marmalade, Fired Brick
- Sentiment Stamps/Dies
- Clear sequins
- Ink Blending tool

Instructions

- 1. Fix the stencil on cardstock, all 4 sides using a low tack adhesive tape.
- 2. Now start applying distress ink colors, using gentle swirling motion.
- 3. When you move new color over the previous color, it blends seemlessly.
- 4. After Inking, splatter a few drops of water in the background.
- 5. Add Sentiments using stamps and dies
- 6. Glue some clear sequins for interest

- **★** White Cardstock 2.75"5.75"
- **★** CrafTreat Stencil- CTS273 Goals
- Distress Ink Fossilized amber, Worn Lipstock, Peacock feathers
- Folkart Acrylic Paint Licorice
- Ink blending tool
- **≰** Stencil brush

- 1. Take a piece of White Cardstock and blend the distress ink colors with ink blending tool
- 2. Now secure the stencils on cardstock and apply the black color paint through it with stencil brush
- 3. Now Mat the colored cardstock on the black cardstock
- 4. Make a hole at the top and tie a thread with tassel at the end
- 5. your bookmark is ready!



Glass Etched Clock

Skill Level: Easy



Simple yet, wow looking clock in just minutes!!





- Plain Glass 12"x12"
- Folk Art Glass Etching Paste
- **♦** CrafTreat Stencil − CTS358 Peacock Dot Mandala
- **★** Low Tack Spray Adhesive
- **s** Brush
- Hand Gloves
- Clock Mechanism

- 1. Clean the glass thoroughly and let it dry. Mark the center of the glass and drill a hole for clock.
- 2. Secure the stencil on the glass with low tack spray adhesive. The center of stencil, should lie on the center of the glass
- 3. Wear your gloves and apply glass etching paste through stencil.
- 4. After 5-10 minutes, carefully remove the stencil from one end.
- 5. Wash the glass. Frame the glass and Fix clock mechanism.



Pot Painted Jewellery

Supplies Used

- **★** EK Success Circle Punches 2", 2.5", 0.125"
- Chipboard for Punching
- Bangle Base
- ★ Folk Art Acrylic Paint Licorice
- **★** FolkArt 3D paint − Orange, Green, Yellow
- Pencil
- **♥** Varnish

Instructions

For Earring and Pendant


- 1. Use EK Success Circle Punch and punch chipboard circles. 2" Circles for Earring and 2.5" Circles for Pendant
- 2. Using 0.125" Circle punch, punch holes 1 in the top, 3 or 5 in the bottom of the chipboards
- 3. Stack and glue together 2-3 chipboards, depending upon the thickness you need.
- 4. Paint them black with FolkArt Licorice Acrylic paint. Let them dry.
- 5. Secure the Stencil on the Earring/Pendant base, with a tape.
- 6. Using your pencils with the stencils, mark all the circles on the Earring / Pendant Base.
- 7. Now remove the stencils and start dropping dots with 3D Paint, following a Pattern.
- 8. Let them dry for 12 hours.
- 9. Varnish them completely.
- 10. Hang tassels at the bottom and Earring hooks at the top.





- 1. Bangle is a curved surface and one needs to excise caution, when marking the dots. Or you may end up with crooked markings.
- 2. Follow the same instructions as for Earrings with stencil Dot Border Once done varnish it thoroughly.







Multi-layered stencils

Multi-layered stencils are used to create images with more detail and depth than you can achieve with single layered stencils. Each stencil layer will have registration marks cut into them so that you can quickly and easily line up each stencil layer.









Create a City Scape Scene By Neha Bhatt

Skill Level: Intermediate



Impress your loved one with a Handmade Personalized card, which says "You Color my World". This vibrant two Layered Card, will steal his/her heart.



Supplies Used

- CardStock
- **★** CrafTreat Stencil CTS054 CityScape
- **★** 3M Painters Masking Tape½ inch
- Distress Inks Picked Raspberry, Mustard Seed, Spiced Marmalade, Shabby Shutters, Faded Jeans, Frayed Burlap, Lucky Clover, Black soot, Blueprint sketch
- Sentiment stamps
- **♥** White Gel Pen
- Glitter Washi Tape
- Ink Blending tool

Instructions:

- 1. Pick up a Cardstock and secure the Layer 1 of stencil on all 4 sides.
- 2. Ink the individual building with different Distress inks by using masking tapes. Ref Pic.





- 3. Once done, secure the Layer 2 of the stencil, aligning it with inked image.
- 4. Now, add detail with the same inks Pink on pink, blue on blue..etc
- 5. Remove the stencil and mask the inked buildings fully.
- 6. Blend Black soot and Blue print sketch distress inks to create sky in the background.
- 7. Remove the mask.
- 8. Add dots with white gel pen. Add sentiment and grey glitter washi tape to finish of the card.



Canvas Wall Clock

Skill Level: Intermediate





Observe and Reflect and Become a Little Wiser Everyday, Every Moment. "Dabble with different Paints and Stencil and create this Unique piece of Art/Clock!





- Triangle Canvas Frame
- **★** CrafTreat Stencil CTS219 Be Wise
- Clock Mechanism
- ♣ Folk Art Acrylic Paints Aqua, True Blue, Ultramarine, Sunny Yellow, Bright Pink, Perfect Purple, Wicker White, Licorice
- **♦** Varnish
- **■** Stencil Brush
- Paint Brush

- 1. Using 3 shades of blue from Aqua to True Blue to Ultramarine, color blend the canvas. Do it till you are satisfied with the results.
- 2. On some areas distress the canvas with a shade ofBright pink,Perfect-purple and very little black.
- 3. With the help of a brush, paint the Craftreat Owl Stencil design using white acrylic paint.
- 4. Also use the same white paint to stencil the numbers 12 and 6 on the top and bottom of the canvas.
- 5. Colour the clock hands with Yellow acrylic paint. Let them dry.
- 6. Once happy with all the colour combos, apply two generous coats of varnish giving 3-4 hours of drying time between each coat.
- 7. Pierce the center of the canvas and set up the clock mechanism with batteries. Viola! Your clock is ready!!





Altered Melamine Plates By Priya Satish

Skill Level: Intermediate



Convert your Old Melamine | Ceramic | Glass Plates into Beautiful Home décor pieces. This vintage style décor, is sure to catch anybody's attention!!





- Melamine Plates
- **♦** Craftreat Stencil CTS134 Lonely Man. CTS133 Lonely Woman
- FolkArt Black Gesso
- **★** FolkArtMultisurface Paint Licorice
- **★** FolkArt Brushed Metallics Bronze
- All purpose glue
- Chunky glitter Bronze
- Stencil Brush
- Paint Brush
- Mod Podge Dishwasher

- 1. Give a coat of Black Gesso and let it dry. This will ensure all the paints stick to slick surface. You can skip this step if you want.
- 2. Next give a Coat of Multisurface Licorice paint and let it dry.
- 3. Secure the Lonely Man/ Woman stencil on the plate
- 4. Apply Glue through the Stencils and sprinkle bronze chunky glitter on it.
- 5. Dab with finger and make sure all the glitter sticks to it. Tap off the excess.
- 6. Pick up a little Brushed Metallics Bronze paint with a Flat brush and Dry brush it on the edges strokes should be towards the center.
- 7. Once dry apply, Dishwasher safe Mod Podge to make it water proof. Your Altered Vintage Home Decor is ready!!

Tips

Replace Bronze with Gold color, if you do not want the vintage look



Rustic Chalk Board Tray By Jaanhvi Hinduja

Skill Level: Intermediate



What could be a better start to a day than to serve a hot cup of coffee in a beautiful handmade tray?! That too, when it is made with your own hands!



Supplies Used:

- MDF Tray
- **★** CrafTreat Stencils CTS279 Authentic Kitchen
- **★** Folk Art Chalk Paint Java, Irish , Rich Black, Sheep Skin
- Folk Art Sanding Block
- Flower Designs for Decoupage
- Folk Art Home Decor Wax
- Mod Podge Matte
- Stencil Brush
- Paint Brush

Instructions:

- 1. Paint the sides of the tray with Folk Art Chalk Paint Java and let it dry naturally. Then apply Folk Art Home Decor Wax to areas where you want to distress.
- 2. Top coat them with Irish Color and Sand it to get the desired Rustic look.
- 3. Paint the center of the tray with Folk Art Rich Black, for chalk board effect.
- 4. Apply Folk Art Chalk Paint Sheep Skin on the stencil to get down the text on the tray. After it is dry, apply mod podge on the text through the stencil to make it long lasting.
- 5. Cut the outlines of Flower design Decoupage Paper / Napkin you want to use. Stick the flower on the tray using Mod Podge.
- 6. Seal the entire tray with Mod Podge and let it dry. Now your tray is ready to serve!

Poodled Terra Cotta Bottles/Pots By Mona Diwan

Skill Level: Intermediate



Doodling is the Brooding of the hand. So why not give your hand, a chance to tell, what it wants to?! Our Stencils will make your doodling prettier!!





- Terracotta Bottles and Pots
- **♦** CrafTreat Stencils = CTS101 Tribal Potters, CTS039 Warli
- **★** FolkArt Home Décor Chalk Paint − Sheep Skin
- **★** FolkArtMultisurface Paint Licorice
- Sharpie Black Marker
- Stencil Brush
- Sandpaper
- **s** Brush
- **★** Varnish

- 1. Sand the surface of Bottles and Pots.
- 2. Apply 1- 2 coats of Off White Chalk Paint on the Bottles. No Priming required for chalk paints
- 3. Secure the Tribal Potters Stencil on the bottles with repositionable spray adhesive
- 4. Since this is a Curved surface, excise caution while tracing the outline of the tribal women.
- 5. Now remove the stencils and start doodling inside the women.
- 6. Secure the Warli Stencils at the bottom of the bottles and paint them Red.
- 7. For the pots, Secure the Warli Stencils at the centre and paint them Black.
- 8. Varnish them with Mod podge.






Fridge Magnet Post it Notes Holder

- **▲** Magnetic Sheet 4"x7"
- **♦** CrafTreat Stencil − CTS201 Life is a Beautiful Ride
- Post it Sticky Notes
- Beige Cardstock
- Color Markerss
- **♦** Varnish

- 1. Secure the stencil on the beige cardstock and color the cycle in different colors using markers
- 2. Remove the stencil and Stick the cardstock onto the magnetic sheet
- 3. Varnish the whole sheet
- 4. Fold a dark brown cardstock and paste it near the bottom right edge of the magnet. This will be the pen/pencil holder.
- 5. Now stick the sticky note pad on the edge of pen holder
- 6. Fridge Magnet Post it Notes Holder is Ready!



Spray Stenciled Fondant Cake

Skill Level: Intermediate





This lovely decoration will definitely add sophistication to your delicious cakes.





- **₡** Cake 6" tall and 6" Diameter
- **★** CrafTreat Stencil CTS025 Ombre Square
- Rolkem Gold with Evaporex mixed to spray
- Spray gun
- Parchment Paper

- 1. Bake the cake and cover it with Black Fondant
- 2. Tape the ends of the stencil to parchment paper going around the cake
- 3. Rolkem Gold with Evaporex mixed to spray, Airbrush it through the stencils
- 4. Remove it and repeat the same 1-2 more times to go around the cake.
- 5. Your cake would be dazzling to say the least!

Stenciled CardStock Photo Frame

Skill Level: Intermediate

Supplies used

- ★ White Cardstock 12" 2 pieces
- **©** CrafTreat Stencil − CTS335 3D Square Pattern, CTS282 Live Laugh Love
- Stencil Brush
- Distress ink Antique Linen, Fossilized Amber, Wild Honey.
- Ink Blending tool
- Ribbon

Instructions

- 1. Secure the stencils on cardstock using low tack tape.
- 2. Using the Antique Linen Distress ink, stencil the whole cardstock.
- 3. Now rotate the stencil 90` and stencil the whole cardstock with Fossilized Amber Distess Ink. Repeat the same process again, with Wild Honey Distress ink.
- 4. This will give a 3D effect, to the cardstock.
- 5. Now Follow this tutorial and make photo frames out of cardstocks Inna's creation.
- 6. Stencil down the Live Laugh Love Sentiment on a White cardstock. Paste it in one of the squares.
- 7. Your family photo can be placed in the other Square frame.
- 8. Hang them using Ribbon or hinge them together and place them on your desk!



Tribal Tea Coaster Set

Skill Level: Intermediate



Adorned with beautiful Stenciled Tribal Faces and masks that bring in the mood of celebration and happiness, every time you use it!





- Folkart Chalk Paint Sheep Skin
- **★** Folkart Acrylic Paints Licorice, Sunny Yellow, Pure Orange
- **© CrafTreat Stencil − CTS107 Congo Mask, CTS106 Tribal faces**| background |
- Ranger Stickles Gold
- Stencil Brushes
- Varnish/ Mod Podge

Instructions:

- 1. Carefully paint the sides of the coasters with Licorice.
- 2. Cover the front and back of the coasters with FolkArt Chalk Paint Sheep skin.
- 3. Using Sunny Yellow and Pure Orange acrylic colors on the Tribal Faces Background stencil, blend the colors with Stencil Brushes
- 4. Using the Congo Mask Stencil with Licorice, paint the Mask designs on the coasters.
- 5. Once dried, use the stickles to add small dots around the edges of the stenciled design
- 6. Varnish 2-3 coats, to make it waterproof. Your Tea Coasters are ready!!






Happy Home Wall Hanger/Key Hanger

A Cute little way to change your House to Home with a Handmade touch!!



Supplies Used:

- **★** Wood plank
- **★** FolkArt Gesso
- CrafTreat Stencil CTS058 Positive Negative Flourish, CTS274
 Happy Home, CTS092 Woodgrain
- FolkArt White Texture Paint
- FolkArt Chalk Paint Castle
- **★** FolkArt Acrylic Paint Licorice and Indian Red
- Brown Cardstock
- Flowers and Leaves Die cut
- **♦** Stencil Brush
- **E** Brush
- **★** Varnish

Instructions

- 1. Cover the Wooden Plank with White Gesso
- 2. Fix the Happy Home Stencil on the wood plank and ink the sentiments
- 3. Fix the Flourish Stencil on the edges and use the Texture paint
- 4. Apply Grey Chalk paint on edges with sponge
- 5. Ink the Woodgrain Stencil on Brown cardstock and make it bucket shape and fix.
- 6. Take some Die cut / Readymade Birds, flowers and leaves. Glue them down inside the bucket.
- 7. Varnish the complete project and Fix the Key holders. Your project is ready






Buddha Mixed Media Canvas

Skill Level: Advanced





Supplies Used:

- Mounted Canvas Frame

- Folk Art Brushed Metallics Gold, Copper
- Folk Art Gesso
- Mod Podge Matte
- Newsprint paper
- Double Side Foam Tape
- Rose Stamp
- Black Marker for drawing
- Stencil Brush
- Paint Brush

Instructions


The Canvas has a few prominent elements apart from the main element of Buddha's face.


- 1. Leaves and the overall colour scheme signifying the Bodhi tree under which Buddha sat for meditation.
- 2. The numericals signifying the knowledge He received.
- 3. The Roses signifying the attainment of complete Enlightment, like knowledge blooming within.
- 4. Apply a coat of Mod Podge and decoupage a layer of Newspaper on Canvas.Make sure that, there are no air bubbles.
- 5. Apply a Layer of Gesso to tone down the print.
- 6. The second layer has acrylic paints. Cream, Yellow, Different shades of Green, Blue and Golden in a very light single coat
- 7. Draw the leaves on the left side and colour them with paints. Mark a few numbers on the top right.
- 8. Near the leaves,apply a bit blue and gold with the help of Ombre square stencils.



- 9. Waterdown the blue color and drop a few drops from the top. Allow it to freely flow down.
- 10. Take a bubble wrap, dip it in gesso and stamp it in a couple of places
- 11. Stencil Down Buddha Face with Black paint.
- 12. The crown area and ear lobes can be given a copper gold touch with the help of Brushed Metallics paints.
- 13. UseOld Ivy and Licorice colors on the sides here and there to give definition to the edges
- 14. The last and final addition is the stamped and colored image of roses. Stick them to the canvas with Double Sided Foam Tape to give it a dimension.


