

Rules and Regulations

Guidelines

The intent of the Ranch Fuel Super Slide Contest is to highlight the signature reining maneuver...The slide! This is a serious competition with rules that must be followed in order for Ranch Fuel to pay out the prize money as agreed upon.

- 1. The name of the contest always needs to be shown as "Ranch Fuel Super Slide" or "Ranch Fuel Super Slide Contest"
- 2. A Ranch Fuel arena banner needs to be placed at the far end of the arena where the slide takes place on both sides of the arena. Banners will be provided by Ranch Fuel.
- 3. The Ranch Fuel Super Slide must take place in the shows designated main arena

Money Payout

- 1. The payout is as follow:
 - a. 32% for 1st place
 - b. 12% each for places 2nd through 5th
 - c. 4% each for places 6th through 10th

General Rules

- 1. The class is open to anyone (there is no non-pro division)
- 2. The rider does NOT need to own the horse (even a non-pro)
- 3. One rider can enter TWO horses only

Judging

- 1. The maneuver is judged on the run into the arena and the sliding stop. NO BACK UP.
- 2. There are 4 judges and ALL scores count
- 3. The judge is evaluating the standard criteria outlined in the NRHA handbook
 - a. Approach
 - b. Form & Style
 - c. Degree of Difficulty
 - d. Finesse/Willingness
 - e. Physicality
- 4. The judge is to score from 0 to 10 using .5 increments with 10 being perfect.
- 5. There are no marker penalties
- 6. Western attire (long sleeve button down and cowboy hat)
- 7. Entry fee is up to show management
- 8. Drag is preferred after every run but not required
