are based on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. The **intensive courses** for all ages are divided in stages of five weeks each. At the end of each level, a level test has to be passed to move on to the next higher level.

For total beginners, the course start is possible at the beginning of an A1 level. Students with previous knowledge of German can join an already running course.

Thanks to a comprehensive **placement test**, we can place students according to their knowledge, ensuring small and homogeneous classes.

All students, from beginners to advanced learners, are taught at the level that suits them best and are efficiently guided on their way to the desired learning goal.



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Teaching and Learning

Only German is spoken inside and outside the classroom. In our **total immersion concept**, students dive into the German language right from the beginning.
