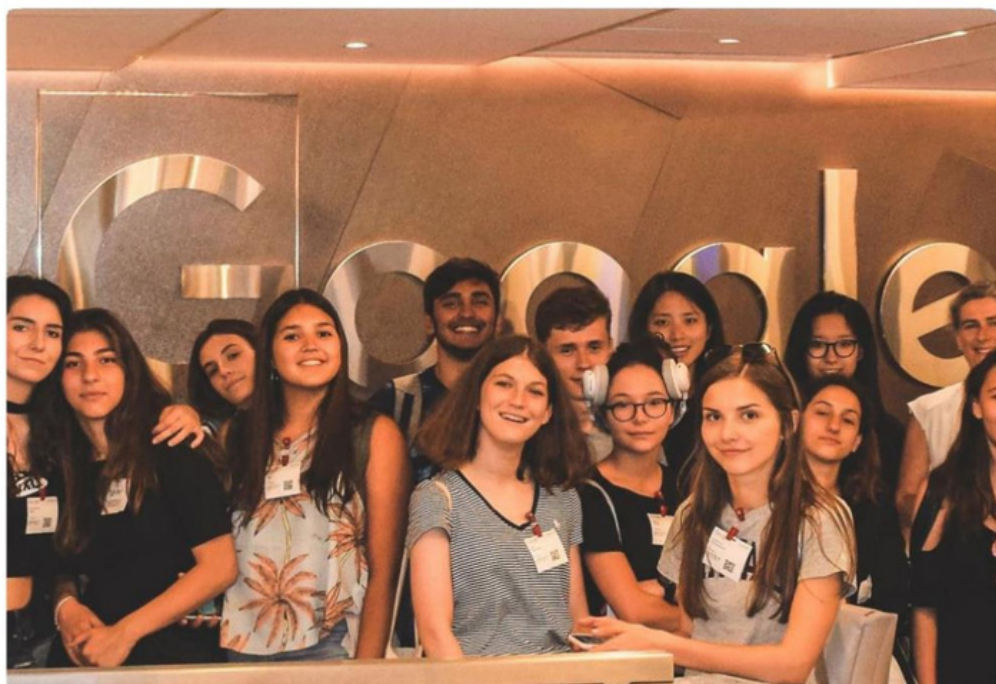

## COGITO SUMMER PROGRAM INCLUDES:



### **SAT/ACT Classes**

Students attend SAT classes 5 days a week. On Saturdays, we offer college essay workshops. All our faculty are Harvard, MIT and Boston University graduates. We administer two SAT diagnostic tests during the program.



### **Lectures and Workshops**

Our students attend:

- Lectures by Harvard and MIT professors
- Workshops at top companies such
- Entrepreneurship + Innovation events with Boston-area start-ups.



### **Individual Social Impact Projects**

Cogito pairs students with Boston start-ups and research labs to work on a project according to student interests. Every project addresses a different global challenge. Acting and singing workshops



### **Campus Visits**

Students attend admission info sessions and tour campuses at Brown University, Harvard University, Boston College, MIT, Tufts University and Boston University.

International health insurance.



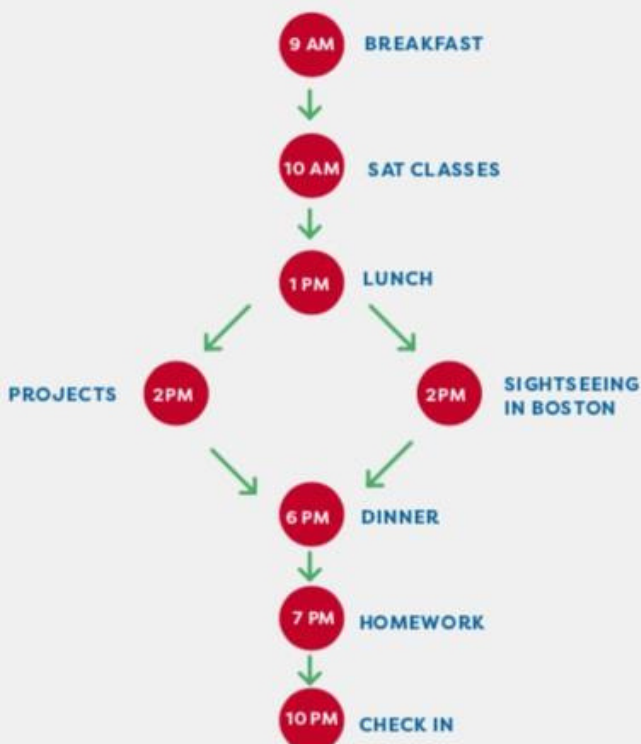
