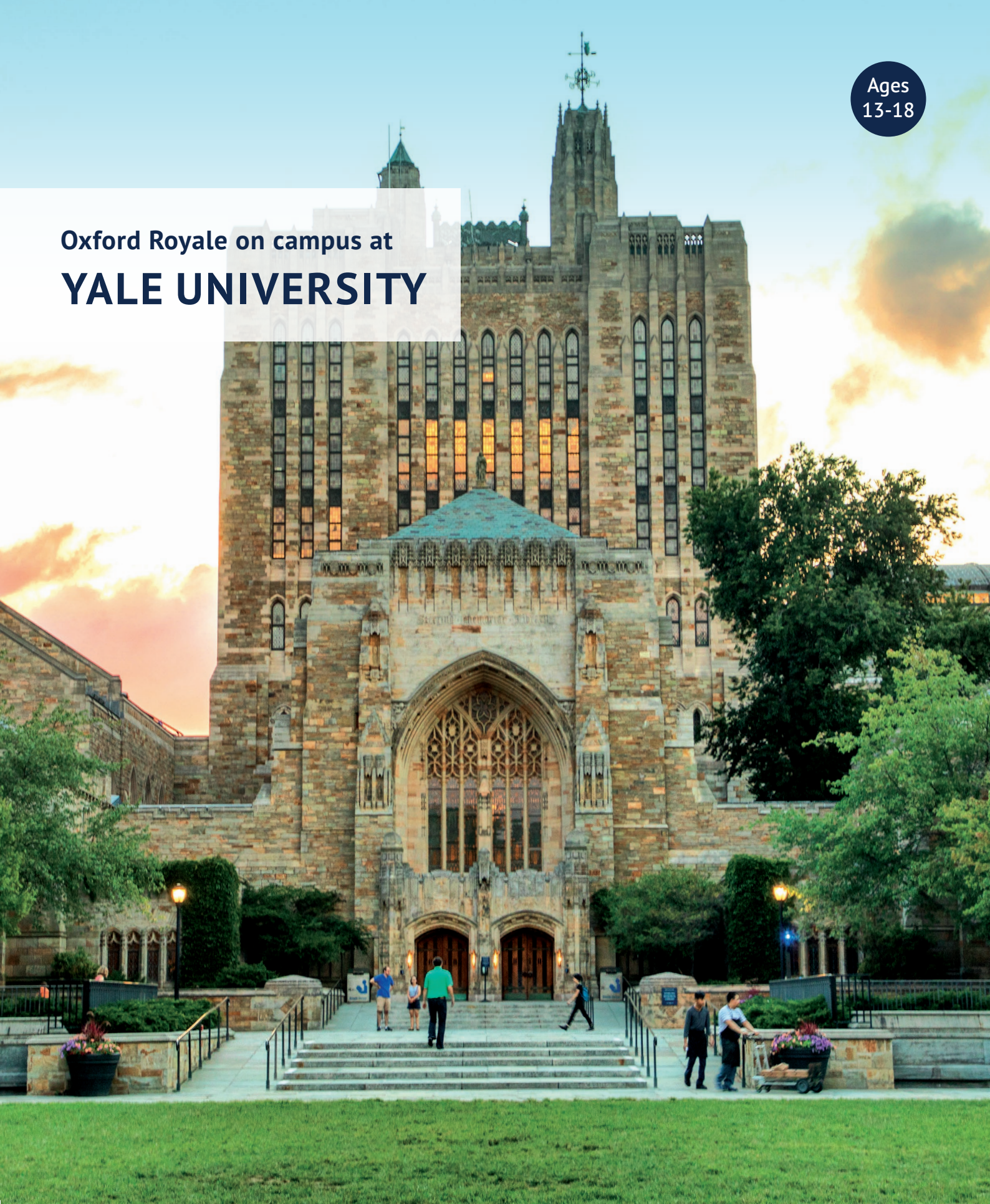

Notable Yale Alumni

- 5 US Presidents, including Bill Clinton and George W Bush
- 19 US Supreme Court justices, including 4 of the 9 current judges
- Academy Award winners Edward Norton, Paul Newman, Meryl Streep and Lupita Nyong'o
- Innovators such as the inventor of Morse code Samuel Morse, and the founder of Boeing William Boeing
- Benjamin Silliman, the first person to distill petroleum, was one of the first professors of science at Yale College and a renowned science educator
- Ben Carson, renowned neurosurgeon who led the first separation of twins conjoined by the back of the head



See New Haven

New Haven is one of the oldest cities in the United States, immersed in history and the prestige of a world-famous university.

The best way to tour New Haven is on foot. Since the histories of New Haven and Yale University are thoroughly intertwined, our summer school includes a comprehensive tour of Yale's beautiful gothic campus, including sites such as the Payne Whitney Gymnasium, one of the largest gyms in the world!

With Oxford Royale, students can visit the fascinating cultural attractions that Yale has to offer, including the Beinecke Rare Book & Manuscript Library, which hosts a copy of Gutenberg's 1455 bible, the Peabody Museum of Natural History and the Yale University Art Gallery.

Visit the Big Apple

We'll take a trip to New York, a city buzzing with an energy like no other. Whilst there, students will have the chance to see some of the world's most recognisable sights – from the Statue of Liberty to Central Park and Times Square - there's an Insta-worthy photo opportunity on every corner.

Students will get the chance to experience the history and culture of one of the greatest cities in the world, visiting locations such as the Ellis Island National Museum of Immigration, the Metropolitan Museum of Art and the Guggenheim Museum.

'The city that never sleeps' is a leader in many areas, and students will be able to see some of the most important places in the world on their visit to the city: from the home of global finance on Wall Street to the prestigious theatres of Broadway - the centre of the world entertainment industry.

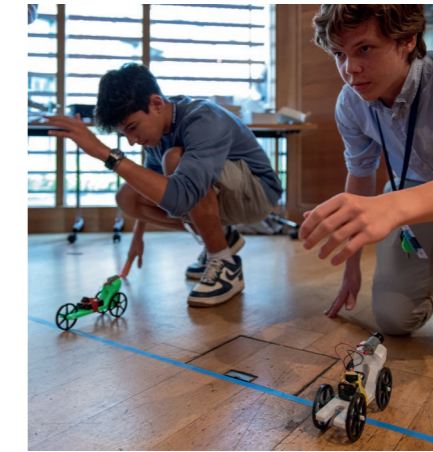

Our online application form takes a few moments to complete and requires the name and details of the student enrolling as well as those of the person paying the fees. All applications require selection of subject, location and dates.

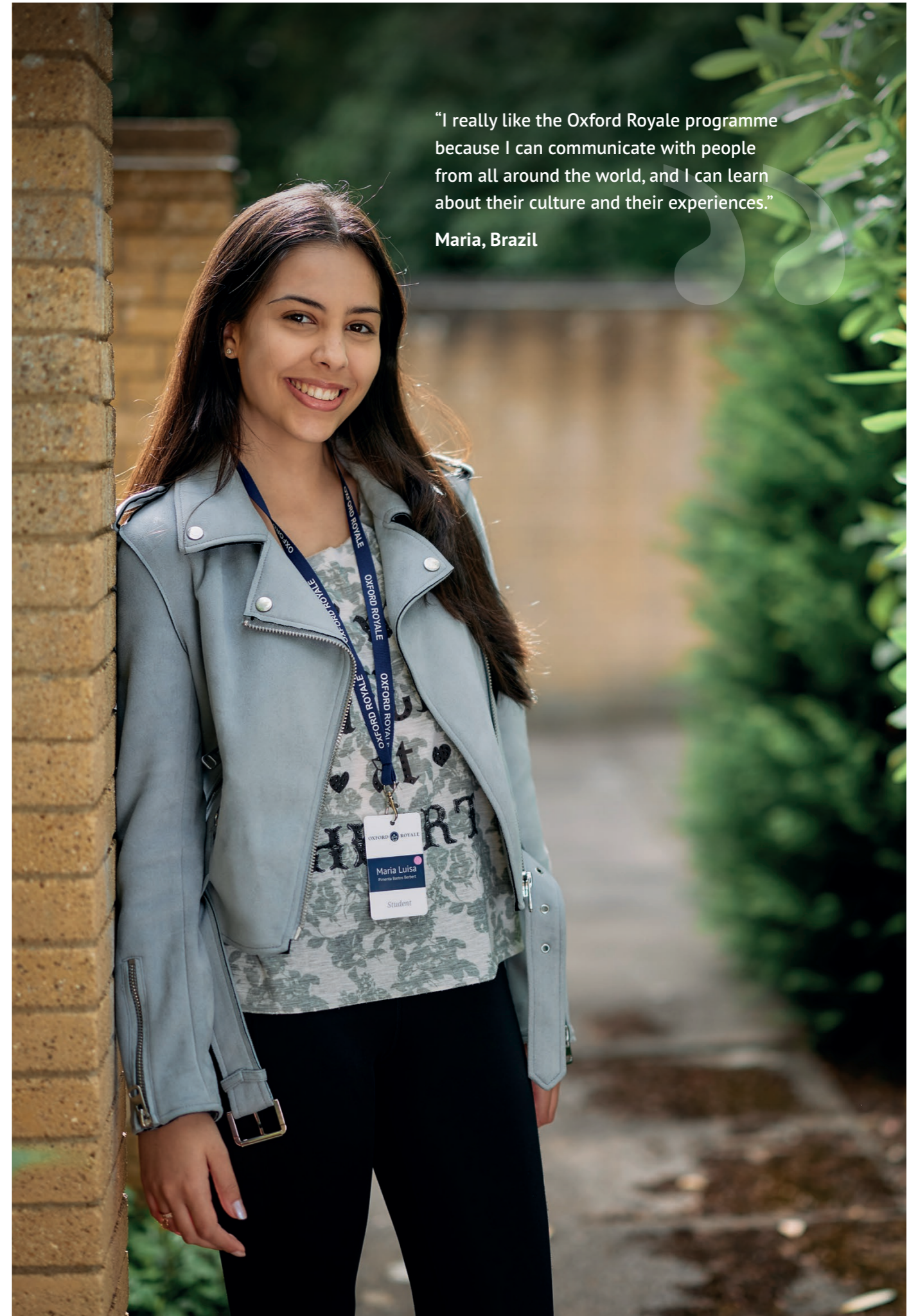
We require payment of the relevant deposit at the time of booking. A credit or debit card payment is preferred, but other options are available on request.

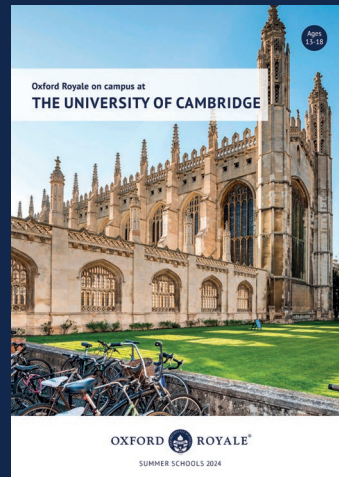

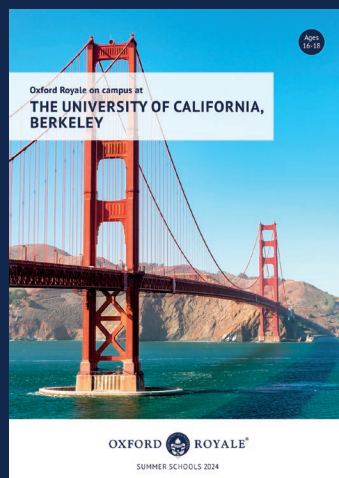
