



## iCBL'S Tesla Emblem Installation Guide



### Materials Needed:

- iCBL's front and rear emblems
- Masking tape
- Thread or finishing wire (dental floss can also work)
- Plastic pry tools or trim removal tools (Optional)
- Rubbing alcohol or adhesive remover
- Microfiber cloth
- Heat gun or hair dryer (optional)

### Installation Steps:

#### Front and Rear Emblem Removal:

- Open the frunk (front trunk) of your Tesla.
- Apply masking tape around the area where the original emblems were to mark their positions precisely. This will help with aligning the new emblems.
- Using the Thread or the finishing wire, gently remove the original front emblem. You can also use a plastic pry tool but be cautious not to damage the paint or the emblem during removal.
- Clean the area where the original emblems were with rubbing alcohol to remove any residue or dirt.

#### Front and Rear Emblem Install:

- Tear off the adhesive backing of the emblem.
  - Carefully align the new front and rear emblems with the marked positions on the masking tape.
  - Press the emblems firmly onto the car's surface to ensure they adhere properly.
  - Use a clean, soft cloth to apply even pressure to the emblems for a minute or two
- Optional: Use Heat (if needed) In colder weather. You can use a heat gun or hair dryer to warm the adhesive before sticking the emblems. This can help with adhesion.

This method ensures a clean and precise emblem replacement while safeguarding the original logo's position.
